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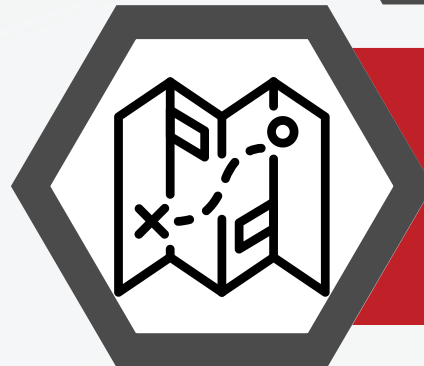

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# COMMUNITY LIVING STANDARDS: GUESTS



## Overnight Guest

Guests visiting after 12:59 a.m. must be approved in advance. Guests staying overnight can be registered at any village office front desk.



## Guest Limitations

8 visits per semester  
2 consecutive nights ONLY, must check them in daily at the office though



## COVID-19

Guests must adhere to the current state, local, university, and housing COVID-19 requirements.



## Escort Guests

Licensed residents must escort their guest everywhere in Housing. If your roommates do not want the guest present, the guest must be escorted out immediately.





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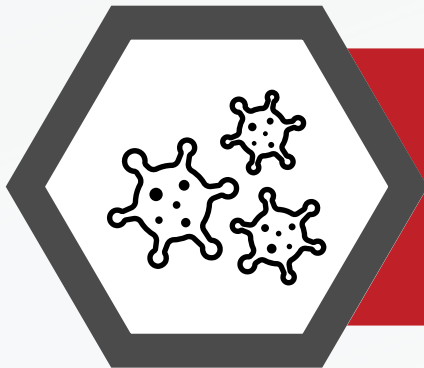
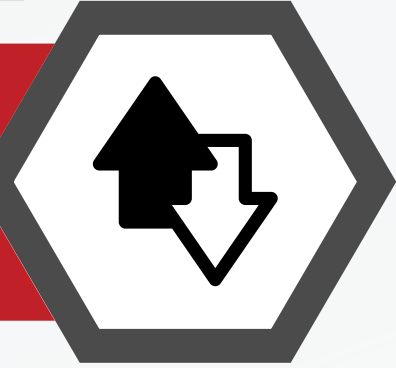

### Common Spaces

- Housing has common spaces available to all residents
- Please take care of the equipment/furniture
- Update desk staff is something is damaged
- Hours vary per building

### Exterior Gate Entry

- Keycard **REQUIRED** (Gates unlock 7 a.m. - 7 p.m.)
- Keep card on you at all times!
- Do not prop gates!

## 04

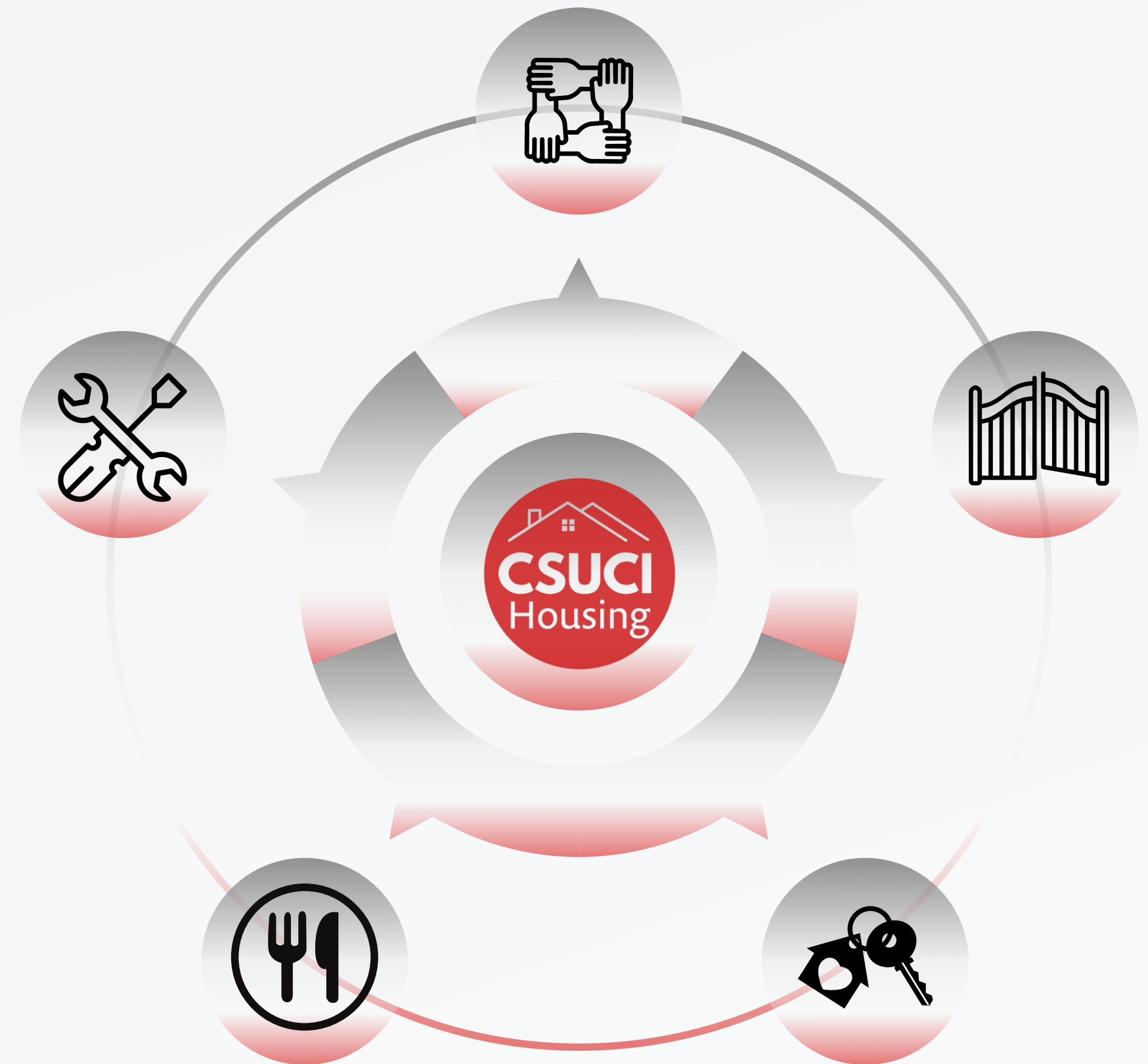
### Dining

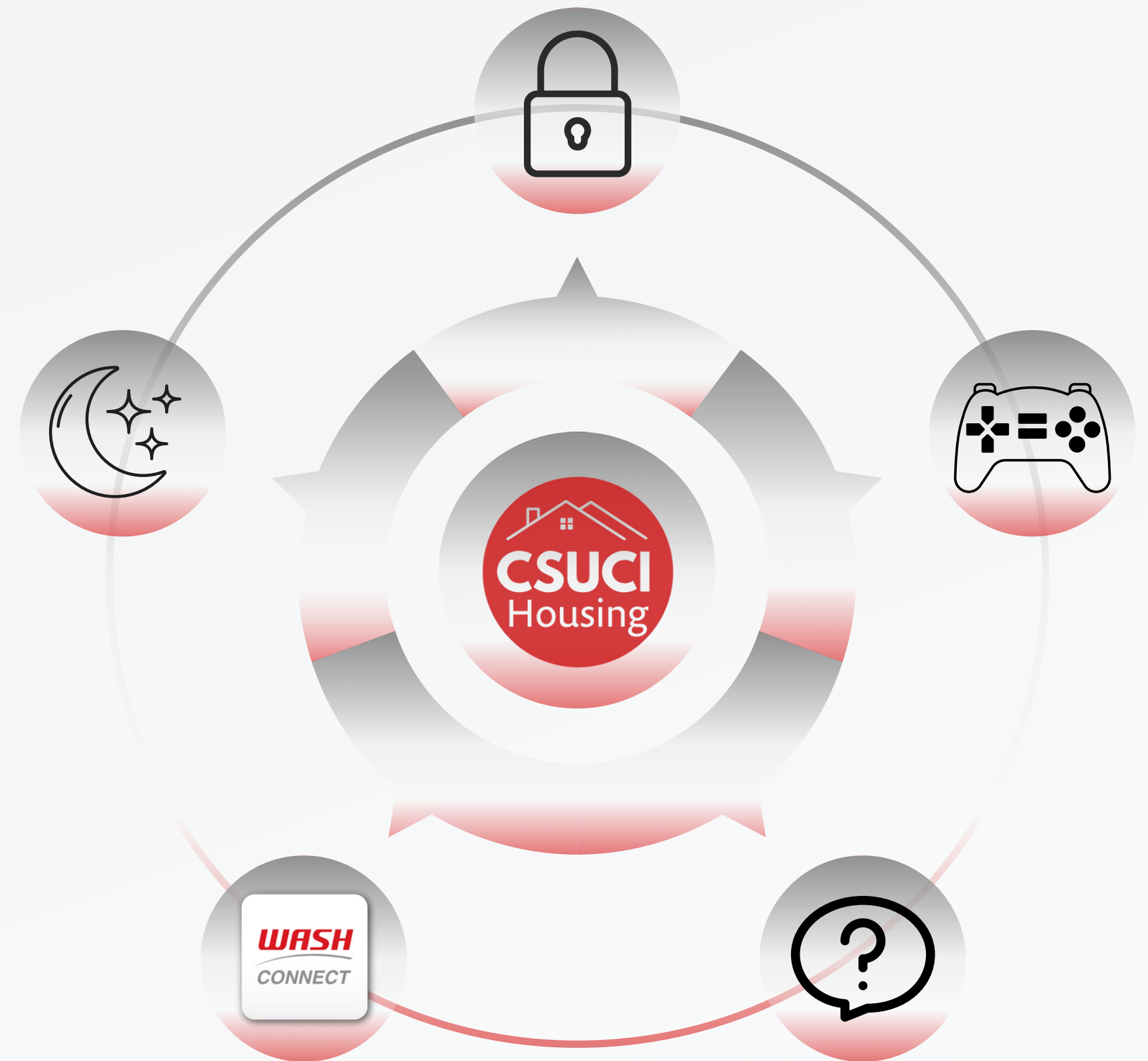
