

Rules for Safe Operation of Powered Carts

The following rules apply to both electric and gasoline powered carts:

- 1. Only trained and authorized employees shall be permitted to operate powered carts.
- 2. Drivers must have a current driver's license and have completed the CSUCI Defensive Driver training course, as well as a Powered Cart Safety course, within the past four years.
- 3. Cart users may not "lend" a cart to any non-authorized person. A cart user is responsible for ensuring the security of the cart to prevent this type of use.
- 4. Carts are not toys- "joy riding" is specifically prohibited.
- 5. In carts equipped with seatbelts, seatbelts must be worn by all vehicle occupants at all times. All passengers must be in a seat while the cart is moving- no exceptions.
- 6. Cart operators and passengers shall keep arms and legs inside the cart at all times and shall not jump on or off moving vehicles.
- 7. Powered carts shall be driven on campus streets whenever possible. If a sidewalk must be used, the vehicle speed should not exceed that of pedestrian traffic Powered carts shall not be driven on lawns, with the the exception of facilities personnel.
- 8. Carts shall not be driven off campus unless they are appropriately equipped (i.e. "street legal") for registration with the California Department of Motor Vehicles.
- 9. Carts shall not exceed 15 mph on all campus roadways.
- 10. Cart operators shall be familiar with, and observe all established traffic laws. Citations will be issued for violations of traffic laws.
- 11. Materials and equipment shall be properly secured so that they will not shift or fall off of moving carts.
- 12. Carts shall not be operated at night without properly working headlights and taillights.
- 13. Carts are particularly subject to tipping- be extremely cautious while making turns abd while driving on uneven surfaces.
- 14. Parking is prohibited near building entrances and exits.
- 15. Cell phone use is prohibited while operating any moving powered cart. Carts shall be parked in a safe location while operating any cell phone or other communication device, such as a walkie-talkie.
