- April 24-26, 2024 (new): WSCUC Reaffirmation of Accreditation Site Visit to CSUCI
- July 26-28, 2024: WSCUC Commission meeting/action

### What has been accomplished in January and part of February 2024?

- √ The Reaffirmation Steering Committee (RSC) formed a writing sub-committee to further refine the self-study and complete the institutional report.
- ✓ RSC members made presentations at Student Government, Staff Council, and Academic Senate meetings.
- ✓ Culture of Assessment work on Program Design shared with academic program chairs; available for review on CSUCI's accreditation website.
- ✓ Funding decisions about academic programs applications to continue Culture of Assessment work were released.
- ✓ RSC held a retreat with participation from President Yao, Provost Avila, deans, academic program chairs and Academic Senate leadership to help

finalize the institutional report.

- √ RSC leadership finalized a draft team's visit schedule and shared it with the WSCUC Visit Team.
- ✓ CSUCI successfully submitted its institutional report for reaffirmation to WSCUC.
- ✓ Spring 2024 accreditation events and report planning conducted.

#### What is TPR?

Thematic Pathway for Reaffirmation (TPR) is a streamlined, alternate pathway for reaffirmation for eligible institutions that demonstrate consistent evidence of a healthy fiscal condition, strong student achievement indicators, and sustained quality performance.
