What is WSCUC?

The <u>Western Senior College and University Commission (WSCUC)</u>, formerly known as "WASC," is the accrediting agency that aids institutions in developing and sustaining effective educational programs, while assuring the community that the accredited institution has met the high standards of quality and effectiveness.

What is TPR?

Thematic Pathway for Reaffirmation (TPR) is a streamlined, alternate pathway for reaffirmation for eligible institutions that demonstrate consistent evidence of a healthy fiscal condition, strong student achievement indicators, and sustained quality performance.

What has been accomplished in Spring 2023?

- ✓ The Reaffirmation Steering Committee was organized into research and writing teams. See organizational chart here.
- ✓ The Reaffirmation Steering Committee (RSC) engaged in self-study, collected data.
- RSC conducted in person and virtual Gallery sessions for students, faculty, staff, and administrators to collect feedback on initial self-study. Total gallery participation was
 - **221** individual faculty, students, staff, and administrators.
- ✓ Two presentations to the Academic Senate about RSC's progress and the reaffirmation process occurred with the comments collected.

- ✓ Thirteen faculty, staff and administrators attended WSCUC's Accreditation Resource Conference to learn more about the new standards, assessment, and accreditation.
- ✓ Facilitators, Drs. Jennifer Mersman and Michael Nguyen, began their work to assist CSUCI assess our culture of assessment. The facilitators held initial discussions with program chairs, deans, staff, and administrators in May 2023.
- ✓ An Institutional Report Editor was selected. Dr. Sohui Lee has accepted the honor of editing the WSCUC Institutional Report. Dr. MacArthur will begin working with the Workgroup Leaders immediately. In the Fall 2023 and Spring 2024, Dr. Lee will edit the comprehensive draft of the Institutional Report, which will be shared to campus by early Spring 2024. Dr. MacArthur is an Associate Professor of English and she has considerable editorial experience.

What will be accomplished in the Summer 2023?

• The Reaffirmation Steering Committee (RSC) teams will continue to engage in the self-study work, incorporating feedback from the in-person and virtual galleries.

RSC retreat will take place in June 2023. Deliverables will include the final draft of institutional component parts.

- RSC will plan for Fall 2023 WSCUC VP Liaison visit, and mock visit.
- RSC will plan to share and collect feedback on the draft Institutional Report via galleries F23.
- Team Leaders will begin planning AY23-24 accreditation events.
- Accreditation website will be updated.
