(1) PROVIDE A DESCRIPTION OF THE ACTIVITY

This is a yearly signature activity done by the Global Languages Program, Chicana/o Studies Program and the Spanish Club. It is in its 12th year. The activity brings students and community together in a celebration of culture involving music, food and friendly interaction. The originally scheduled group, Quetzal, withdrew as we were finalizing their offer letter due to a scheduling conflict, so a new band had to be hired. The original intent was an interactive songwriting workshop with the band followed by the band's performance. In their place, the Spanish Club sought out Monitor, a local group from Oxnard which is comprised of several veteran musicians from the community who shared their perspectives on local music in the area, their experiences and their influences before performing two sets of music which covered a wide gamut of styles of contemporary Latin music. Before the band's set, the campus dance group Danza Tlalco Ollin opened the festivities with their performance of Aztec dance and a short description of their purpose and their music. In between sets, there was a local Charro who came and performed for the crowd in traditional dress, displaying his skills with the lasso and explaining the tradition of the Charro in Mexican culture. There was also Mexican food provided for attendees.

(2) HOW DID THE ACTIVITY RELATE TO A COURSE(S) AND/OR LEARNING

OBJECTIVES? The activity provided attendees a firsthand experience of Pre-Columbian (Aztec dancers), traditional (Charro) and contemporary Mexican and Mexican-American culture. While related to any specific course necessarily, the activity strengthened student awareness of a number of issues described in the CI Mission including: multicultural perspectives, international perspectives, and analysis (and experience) of human products (in the arts) and ideas.

(3) WHAT DO YOU SEE AS THE STRENGTHS OF THE ACTIVITY?

The activity brings the student community together and gives the Spanish Club officers responsibility in helping plan and execute the event. Each year, the plan is to provide a different cultural theme. This year, it unofficially was Mexican and Mexican-American cultures past and present. Next year, the plan is to do a Caribbean theme focusing on its rich cultural heritage. This allows for an out of the classroom experience of culture



stand that can tie into a variety of the outcomes outlined in the mission. The students enjoy the activity and it is one of the rare opportunities to bring a large group of the program faculty together at one time with the students.

(4) WHAT WOULD YOU SAY ARE/WERE THE ACTIVITY'S WEAKNESSES?

This time around, in part because it was my first time organizing the event, there was not enough promotion done to have even better attendance (around 240 attended the event). Because of the varying schedules of members in Spanish Club, there was no decorating done to make Malibu Hall look more festive. The general response was overwhelmingly positive.

(5) HOW WOULD YOU IMPROVE THIS ACTIVITY FOR NEXT TIME?

More promotion will help. Having a clearer theme ahead of time as we do now will allow for more specific learning objective coordination. Attempt to get other student clubs involved in promotion (Communications Club has offered to help on this front next year). Try and get Spanish or a different club to print shirts for the first x number of participants, perhaps coordinate with a graphic design class for the poster design to get more students involved from other disciplines, and provide students in Spanish Club a platform to execute some of their ideas for the event.

(6) WHAT DID YOU LEARN FROM THE PROCESS?

This being my first time organizing the event, I learned a great deal about the production and organization of the event, the variety of moving pieces that must be coordinated and how to deal with a number of unforeseen challenges. I am thankful for all the support that I received from a variety of different people across campus including David Daniels, Jon Brooks, George Pantoja, Antonio Jiménez, Claudia Volpe, Sandra Kornuc and Carmen Krebs who were all very helpful to me along the way and showed me answers to my myriad of questions. I have a better idea of where to start and which steps I need to take to make the event a success.

The overwhelming response from students was positive with the vast majority of students and other attendees rating the event 3 and up on a scale of 1 to 5. There were many positive comments reflecting positively on bringing the community together, learning about culture, the band, the charro performance and the dancers. The prevailing suggestion was that there be at least a few tables set up for dining and that the event have decorations. I had been advised against the tables previously.
