Brief Activity Description	The IRA money will be used in support of two public lectures to be held in the Fall of 2016 and Spring 2017. These lectures are part of a series entitled "Global Histories and their Futures" and are meant to strengthen the world historical portion of the history program/major. In the past these lectures supported leading world historians from California and the country. For the Fall of 2016 we have invited John McNeill, a prominent environmental historian based at Georgetown University. For the Spring of 2017 we have invited Patrick Manning, a prominent scholar of African and World history, who is the current president of the American Historical Association.
Learning Outcomes and Relation to IRA to Course Offerings	The lectures will be tied to the following courses: History 211 and 212 -- World history to and from 1500 History 365 -- Themes of World History History 491-Historiography These classes are offered every semester and readings associated with each scholar will be circulated in each class.
Description of Assessment Process	Students will be asked to write a paper in connection with the scholar's academic writing and the public lecture they attended. Specifically for the historiography class (Hist 491), students will be assigned papers or book chapters written by the presenter. They will write on and discuss the historical approaches of the presenter before attending the lecture.
