Brief Activity Description	The request is for funding for sustainability related projects or events on campus, in effect establishing a sustainability fund for a group of classes. Students will work with faculty and staff to identify areas in which they increase the sustainability of our campus, increase awareness for sustainability issues on our campus, or extend our campus' sustainability activities to a larger population. Examples that were funded and are implementing in AY2014/2015 are smart strips, solar recharging stations, and better signage for recycling. Decisions will be made by students on how funds are to be spent, in conjunction with faculty and OPC. Students will design, plan, implement, and assess the projects. As part of their coursework, students will also determine the sustainability related impacts they have on our campus and community.
