| Brief Activity Description | <p>CI Rainbow is an ongoing project for long-term real-time environmental surveillance of Santa Rosa Island. It is composed of a surveillance network and the supporting infrastructure for data collection, analysis, and visualization.</p> <p>The plan is to install a demonstration version of the infrastructure during the trip in May 2016. That infrastructure will need regular maintenance and evaluation in addition to actual collection of data as well as showcasing it to interested parties such as NPS and potential researchers conducting environmental studies on the island. The stress this turn around will be on the overview of the capabilities of the infrastructure and drawing plans for future expansion.</p> <p>The participants are expected to be a mix of CI Rainbow researchers and researchers from disciplines that are interested in utilizing the capability to automatically collect sensory data and utilizing the CI Rainbow-built tools to view and analyze the data.</p> |
| Learning Outcomes and Relation to IRA to Course Offerings | <p>For the CI Rainbow:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - evaluate the performance of the demonstration infrastructure - fix any discovered issues that require in-person presence - survey potential expansions and additions - gather experience from running the infrastructure on the island for extended period of time - gather the feedback from the "customers" (NPS, SRI researchers) <p>For SRI researchers:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - learn what CI Rainbow can provide - brainstorm application ideas (i.e., the use of the infrastructure for particular course of studies) |
| Description of Assessment Process | <p>Feedback from National Park Service and the management of the Santa Rosa Island Research Station as well as potential other CI "customers" will be the primary basis for the assessment. NPS is to assess the feasibility of a larger installation in the future.</p> <p>Additionally, all participants will complete a survey about the value of the event measured by the perceived degree of meeting the outcomes including the quality of the tutorials.</p> |
