He will present a lecture on his newest research topic, "Big Data in History. He joins an illustrious group of world historians who have been to CI: Kenneth Curtis, Cal State Long Beach, 2004, Paul Spickard, UCSB, 2005, David Christian, San Diego State, 2006, Ned Alpers, UCLA, 2006, John Gillis, Rutgers University, 2008, Karen Wigen, Stanford, 2012, Martin Lewis, Stanford, 2013, Patricia Seed, UC Irvine 2015, David Igler, UC Irvine Spring 2016, and the upcoming lecture by John McNeill, Georgetown</p> <p>Attendance for this lecture generally exceeds 75 and is the highlight of the semester for many students as they get to encounter a professor that they have studied in class.</p>
