
Instructions for Career Finder on DCL

Career Finder can help you find out what your interests are and how they relate to the world of work. In this assessment, you will answer a set of short questions (which takes approximately 5 minutes to complete). Once you are finished, a list of possible careers will be generated for you to explore based on your interests. Follow the instructions below to get started.

- 1. Log in to MyCI. Click on Dolphin CareerLink.
- 2. Go to Resources at the top of the page and click on Career Finder.



3. Click Get Started.




4. Read the instructions. Then click *Next*.



- 5. Answer each of the statements by clicking on one of the following options: *Strongly Dislike, Dislike, Unsure, Like, Strongly Like*.
- After you have answered all of the questions, select how much preparation you are willing to do for your career.
- 7. Select a name for your profile and click Submit.

8. Review the list of careers that have been generated for you. Click on the job title for each occupation to learn more about the outlook, salary, skills, personality, and education associated with each job.
