Cleveland Sage is the most aromatic of all the sages. It blooms in spring and summer, but it is the leaves of the plant that give off the fresh, spicy aroma.





centered white flowers that emerge in spring and summer. The blossoms release a light mock-orange scent.



This evergreen currant produces burgundy flowers in winter and spring, followed by edible fruits. The leaves are what give this shrub its name. When wet or when rubbed they give off a scent reminiscent of wine grapes.











This low spreading shrub blooms sporadically throughout the year allowing both flower and fruit to appear at the same time. The flowers give off a sweet Gardenia scent and are followed by large, edible red berries.
