PLEASE EXPLAIN (1) DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITY:

This activity brought the Debussy Trio to the CSUCI campus. The Debussy Trio has been in existence for 25 years, during which they have recorded several CDs, and have toured extensively – giving many concerts in America and in Europe. The members of this trio record on many movies and TV shows, and their flutist is a member of the L.A. Opera Orchestra. The Debussy Trio demonstrated the harp, flute, and viola for our Music in History class, and they performed many pieces of music for the class.

(2) HOW DID THE ACTIVITY RELATE TO A COURSE(S)

Besides discussing the history of their instruments, the Debussy Trio also performed Impressionist era music – which we have been studying in class. The Trio also performed several pieces of modern  $20^{TH}$  and  $21^{ST}$  century music that have been specially written for their ensemble. This led our class directly into the next section of music that the class was about to learn about. Many aspects of the compositions were discussed, and the students were able to ask questions of the performers.

AND (3) WHAT YOU LEARNED FROM THE PROCESS.

THIS WAS THE FIRST APPEARANCE OF THE DEBUSSY TRIO AT CI. I LEARNED THAT THEY ARE A VERY EXCELLENT ENSEMBLE. #### Text Response
