* Quorum not met, committee will discuss proposal actions and make motions / approvals in waiting.

Review of Remaining Proposals

- S. Sanders asked if anyone had questions or comments upon review of the answers submitted from IRA questions for #684, #690, #688 and #692; #684 (performing arts) gave us breakdown, and recalled that we cut the \$540 in parking; **Motion (in-waiting):** P. Murphy moved to fund the off-campus consultant request; **Second:** S. Aloisio; **In-Favor: ALL IRA #684 approved less \$540 in parking (conditional upon quorum consensus).**
- S. Sanders and D. Wakelee clarified that #688 (SRI trip) breakdown is 20 students at \$75 each; **Motion (in-waiting):** S. Aloisio moved to approve #688; **Second:** P. Murphy; **In-Favor: ALL IRA** #688 is approved (conditional upon quorum consensus).

Motion (in-waiting): P. Murphy moved to approve remaining Cat-II's; Second: S. Aloisio; In-Favor: ALL – all Category II proposals approved (conditional upon quorum consensus).

IRA Cat-III #690: S. Sanders asked if we should cut it to 16 students or keep it at 26 students; E. Salgado is in favor of keeping it at 26; S. Aloisio noted its request to fund supplies, committee reviewed; **Motion (in-waiting):** S. Aloisio moved to cut supplies and meals for #690; **Second:** P. Murphy, with additional comments that we're keeping all of the students in the request by removing supplies and meals; **In-Favor:** ALL – IRA #690 is approved for all 26 students, less cost of supplies (conditional upon quorum consensus). D. Wakelee noted Cl's alternative bus vendor (Pegasus), which may be significantly cheaper than this \$6000 bus quote from Roadrunner.

- S. Sanders estimated an IRA budget difference of \sim \$11,000; D. Wakelee noted that D. Daniels will be going through each IRA proposal for Spring-2014 to determine any monies returned, with early estimation at \sim \$4000; also noted that revenue figures from Financial Services yet to be determined for Spring-2015.
- S. Sanders will email committee members to ask whether to meet again with quorum or to review Cat-III's and vote via email will likely ask for a motion to fund Cat-III proposals ranked 1 through 7.
