Brief Activity Description	This proposal grew out of my desire to begin a music series here at CSUCI similar to the monthly series I hosted for eight years as director of Thousand Oaks Library. I wanted the first artist to be Perla Batalla because she:

- 1) Is a Grammy-nominated vocalist/writer. Her Grammy-nominated record is "Mestiza," which celebrates her Mexican heritage.
- 2) Has toured world-wide as a vocalist for Leonard Cohen.
- 3) Is the songwriter for a play called "Blue House/Hearts on the Outside," a play about Frida Kahlo and Diego Rivera. The event would be called: "Perla Batalla in Blue House/Two Hearts in the Outside."

This IRA grant would:

1) Support a concert by Perla Batalla presents the songs of Leonard Cohen plus songs from her "Mestiza" album.

Leonard Cohen's work has explored religion, politics, isolation, and personal relationships. Cohen has been inducted into both the Canadian Music Hall of Fame and the Canadian Songwriters Hall of Fame as well as the American Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. He is also a Companion of the Order of Canada, the nation's highest civilian honor.

2) Support a reading of the play "Blue House/Hearts on the Outside."

Regarding "Blue House/ ...", Perla writes:

"In 2011, I was commissioned by the Los Angeles County Museum of Art to compose and perform an original composition to celebrate the opening of "In Wonderland; The Adventures of Women Surrealists in Mexico and the US." My writing partner, David Batteau, and I felt right at home with this exhibit. The first of these songs were premiered in 2012 at LACMA featuring The Eclipse String Quartet, Van Dyke Parks, Jon Beasley and Pete Korpela.

"The following years found us building that spark of an idea into a play (written by Oliver Mayer), "Blue House/Hearts on the Inside." (working title). With three actors and ten songs performed by David and I (Perla), this powerful theater piece is inspired by the frescoes, canvasses and private journals of two of the most significant painters of the 20th century: Frida Kahlo and Diego Rivera.

"The songs explore the passion and process of two rare creative geniuses, framed by a fearless love affair charged with ideas of agony, betrayal and devotion ... a love letter to art itself.

"In a time when art and music are marginalized in the education of youth, I am more than ever committed to educational outreach as I travel throughout the country. Exposing young audiences to the beauty of art music and poetry through live theater may be the only hope we have."

This grant would enable CSUCI students and community members to experience first hand the poetry and songs of the wordsmith and wordmaster Leonard Cohen, the art of two 20th century master artists (Frida Kahlo and Diego Rivera), and the Mexican heritage of one of he most respected vocalists performing in the country today.

Thus, students of Art, Music and Chicano/a Studies would benefit from the funding of this grant application.
