1.	Any request to serve alcoholic beverages at a campus sponsored event must be submitted to the Chief of Police at least ten (10) workin days and approved by the President within six (6) working days prior to the actual event.				
2.	Attendance at events where alcoholic beverages are being served shall be limited to members of the sponsoring group and their invite guests. If there are to be persons under the age of 21 in attendance specific strategies must be utilized by the sponsor to restrict the access to alcoholic beverages. What arrangements are in place to ensure that alcoholic beverages will only be served to members of the sponsoring group and their invited guests? What arrangements are in place to ensure that alcoholic beverages will not be served to persons under the age of 21 years?				
3.	Alcohol shall only be consumed or sold in a designated enclosed exterior area and/or inside area. What arrangements are in place to ensure that the sale and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages will remain within the confines of the event?				
4.	Unless otherwise approved by the President alcoholic shall not exceed 3 hours.	beverages shall only	be consumed after 4	1:00 p.m., and the ac	tual serving period
5.	Unless otherwise approved by the President, the sale and/or serving of alcohol shall be accomplished by, and performed under, the direct supervision of an approved licensed and insured purveyor. Which approved purveyor will be used for the sale and/or service of alcohol (name, address, phone number)?				
6.	Suitable non-alcoholic beverages and food shall be made available at all functions when alcoholic beverages are served. What type(s) of food and non-alcoholic beverage(s) will be served?				
7.	The sponsoring organization shall take adequate measures to insure compliance with all of the conditions for issuance of this permit. The sponsoring organization should be cognizant of vicarious liability and the consequences to the organization and the university should a vicarious liability civil suit be filed against the organization when a person attending their event and consuming alcoholic beverages is involved in an accident resulting in personal injury and/or death.
