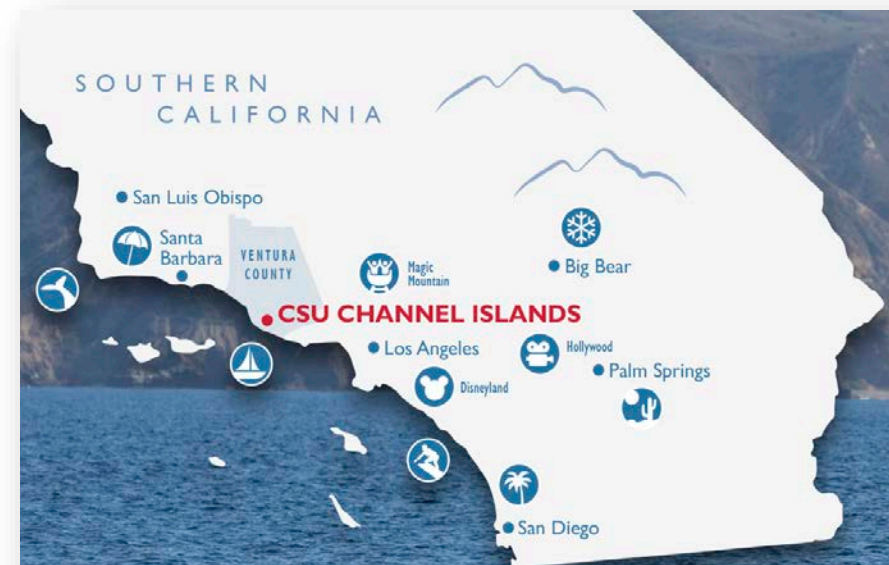

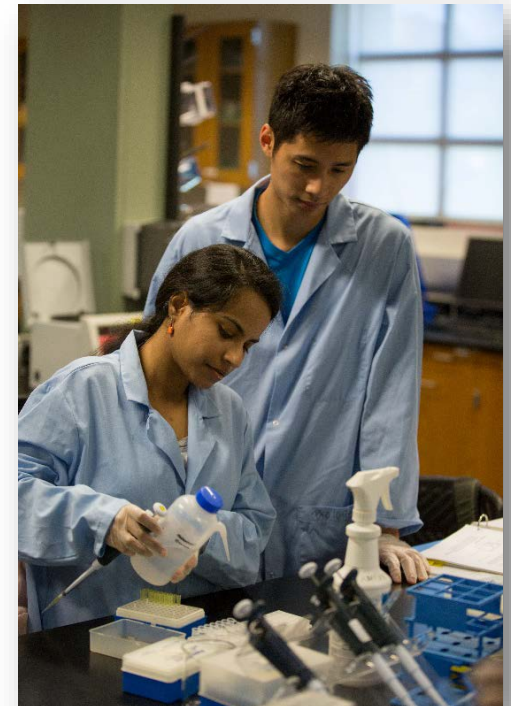

- Basic medical care services such as physical exams, immunizations, and reproductive health

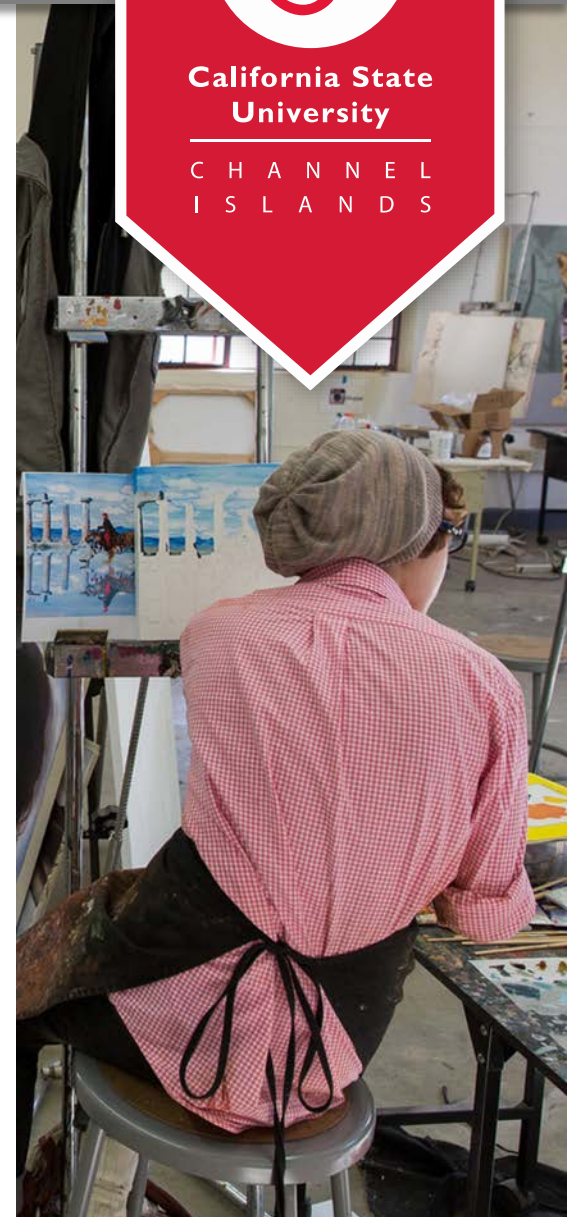

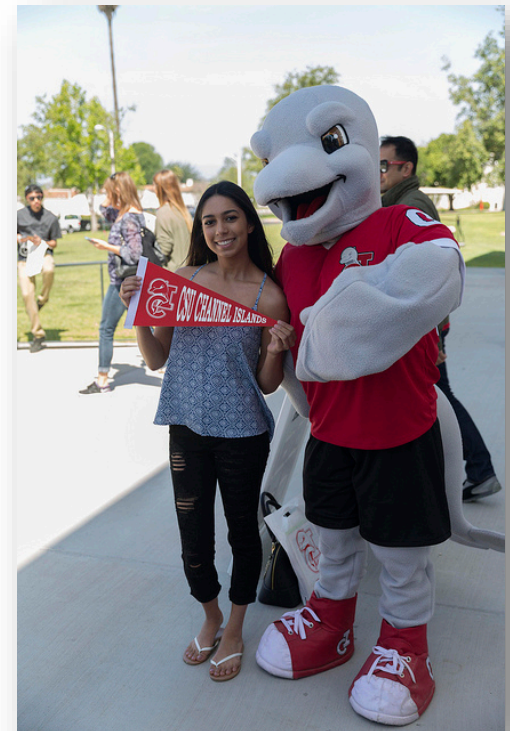

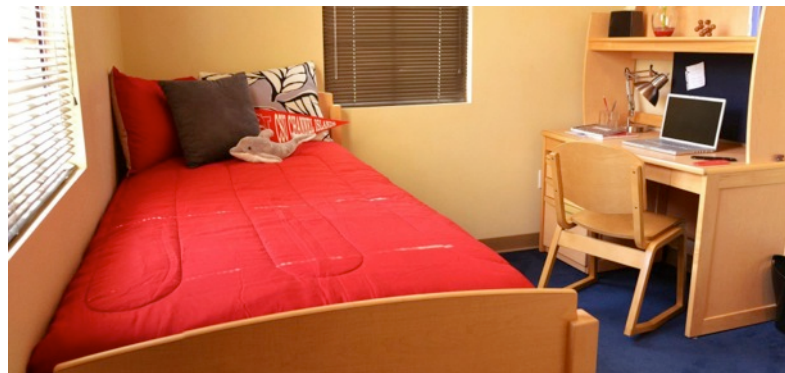

Applications are open twice a year:

- FALL: applicants must complete requirements **by the end of the spring**
October 1st – November 30th
- SPRING: applicants must complete requirements **by the end of summer**
August 1st – August 31st

Website to apply is **www.calstate.edu/apply**

LATE APPLICATIONS ARE NOT ACCEPTED

- \$55.00 application fee for the application
- Admission decision based on self-reported information from application

Transfer Requirements



- 60 transferable semester units or 90 quarter units from a regionally accredited institution.
- Minimum 2.0 GPA in all transferable units completed.
- Be in good standing at the last college or university attended.
- Complete the following classes with a grade of C- or better:
 - A1. Oral communication
 - A2. Written communication
 - A3. Critical thinking
 - B4. College-level mathematics/quantitative reasoning*

**College Algebra is acceptable for the math requirement if it is considered a GE math course at the transfer institution*

Exceptions for Veterans



- Minimum 40 transferable semester units
- Minimum 2.0 GPA
- Be in good standing at the last college or university attended.
- Complete the following classes with grade of C- or better:

A2: Written communication

A3: Critical thinking

B4: College-level math/quantitative reasoning*

**College Algebra is acceptable for the math requirement if it is considered a GE math course at the transfer institution*

Appeal Process

Veteran applicants that do not meet the **standard** transfer requirements will be required to submit an admissions appeal

In-progress transcripts must have completed coursework prior to spring 2017 posted

- Electronic preferred 😊
- Can be mailed or hand delivered but must be official and sealed when received
- It is your responsibility to order transcripts
- Faxed transcripts, printouts, and emails **are not accepted**

In-progress Transcript Deadline:

Monday May 1, 2017



Associate Degrees for Transfer

- CI will allow students to submit verification until May 1
- If you reported an ADT on the application, you do not need to send verification form
- Official transcripts count as verification

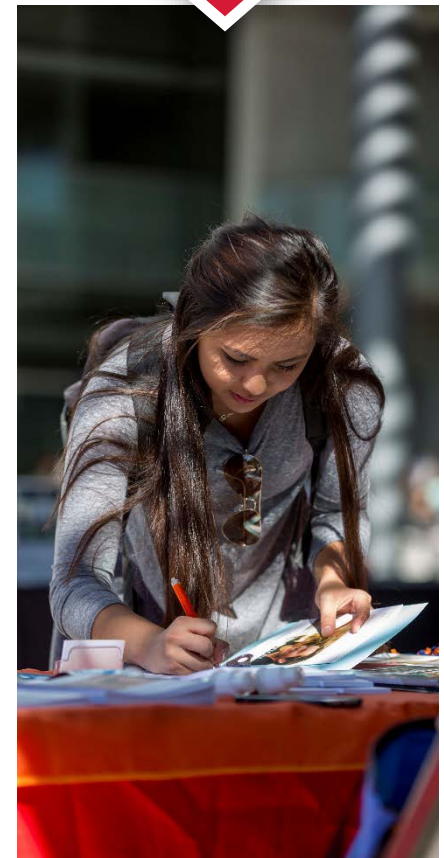
Q: What if I reported that I would be earning an ADT but that is no longer the case?

A: An ADT is not an admission requirement. As long as you will meet the basic admission requirements at the end of spring 2017, you will not be affected.



TRANSFER ENROLLMENT GUIDE FALL 2017 Channel Islands

INTENT TO ENROLL

To reserve your space for Fall 2017, you must complete all 3-steps no later than Monday, May 1, 2017 at 11:59 p.m.

- STEP 1: ACCEPT OUR OFFER OF ADMISSIONS**
 - Log into your [myCSUCI](https://mycsuci.csuci.edu) (<https://mycsuci.csuci.edu>) and click on "CI Records". Your login information was e-mailed upon submitting your admissions application. (We used the e-mail address that was noted on your CSU admissions application. Please check your spam/junk mail folder if necessary.)
 - Scroll down to the bottom of the page (under "Admissions") and click on "Accept" or "Decline". Admissions: "Accept" means that you are electing to enroll at CI for fall 2017 and are responsible for completing the next two steps of the Intent to Enroll process by **Monday, May 1, 2017 at 11:59 p.m.** IMPORTANT: Once you accept our offer of admission, you will be held responsible for paying a \$50 mandatory and non-refundable orientation fee. After accepting our offer of admission, a yellow triangle  will appear and remain until your final transcript has been reviewed. Check your "To Do" list often (located on the right side of your CI Records page) for other enrollment requirements.
- STEP 2: PAY THE NON-REFUNDABLE ORIENTATION FEE: \$50 (Must be paid 48 hours after completing Step 1)**
 - Once you have accepted our offer of admissions and waited 48 hours for the system to refresh, log back into [myCSUCI](https://mycsuci.csuci.edu).
 - Under My Links, click on "CI Records".
 - In the finance section of your student center under "Account Summary", you will see the \$50 orientation fee.
 - Click on "Make a Payment", then click on "Login to CashNet" to pay the required orientation fee by **Monday, May 1, 2017 at 11:59 p.m.**
 - Once in CashNet, click on link for "Make a Payment" on the top menu bar.
 - Click on "General Balance" and enter \$50 for the orientation fee in the "Amount" box.
 - Click on "Add to shopping cart" and then on "Checkout". Follow prompts for entering method of payment.

Students who filed a 2017-18 [FAFSA](https://www.fafsa.gov) application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the [California Dream Act](https://www.csuci.edu/transfer-intention-orientation-payment-sessions.pdf) application on or before **Thursday, March 2, 2017 deadline** AND have an Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) of 4,000 or less, will be considered for a deferment of the new student orientation fee. We are unable to grant a deferment until the results of your financial aid application ([EFC](https://mycsuci.csuci.edu) or [California Dream Act](https://mycsuci.csuci.edu)) is shared with us. If a deferment is not granted, you will need to pay your orientation fee no later than **Monday, May 1, 2017 at 11:59 p.m.**

Deferment means that payment of the orientation fee will be charged to your fall semester's account. If you are determined to be eligible for financial aid and you choose not to enroll or your admission is canceled or revoked, you are still held responsible for paying the orientation fee. Financial aid will not cover expenses owed to CSU Channel Islands if you fail to enroll as planned or when your admission is canceled or revoked.
- STEP 3: CHOOSE A MANDATORY ORIENTATION SESSION**

The third and final step of the Intent to Enroll process involves registering for a one-day mandatory orientation session in early June (week of June 18). Log into [myCSUCI](https://mycsuci.csuci.edu) under my links, click on "Orientation" in order to register for the session pertaining to your major. You are required to attend the entire program. If you do not attend, arrive late or leave during any portion of the program, your admission will be withdrawn and you will need to reapply for the next available term.

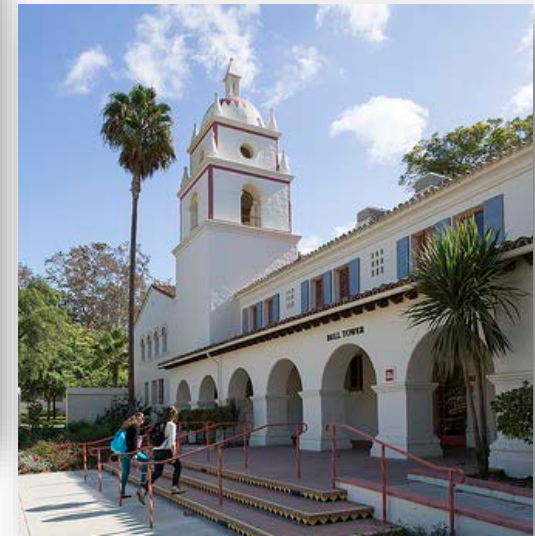

When to Register

- Registration occurs after Orientation
- Students must attend Orientation in order to register
- Holds that prevent registration are placed on students who do not attend
- Enrollment appointments and any holds will appear in your Student Center

Pre-requisites

- If you have not met a pre-requisite, you will receive an enrollment error
- Review course descriptions ahead of time
- Final transcript may be needed
 - *Cannot post in progress coursework to your record*
- Review transfer credit report
- Plan ahead – All transfer coursework will be evaluated before the start of your first term, but not before you register

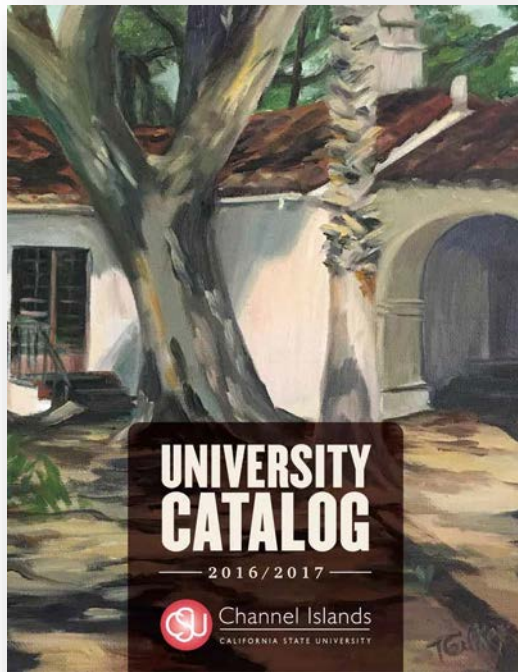

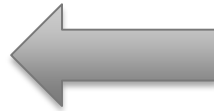

Time to Graduation

- How long will it take me to graduate?
 - Total units needed to graduate 120
 - Most transfer enter with 70 so you'll need at least 50
 - In most cases your major is NOT 50 units so you will need electives
 - So how long? 50 units in four semester is an average of 12.5 units per semester

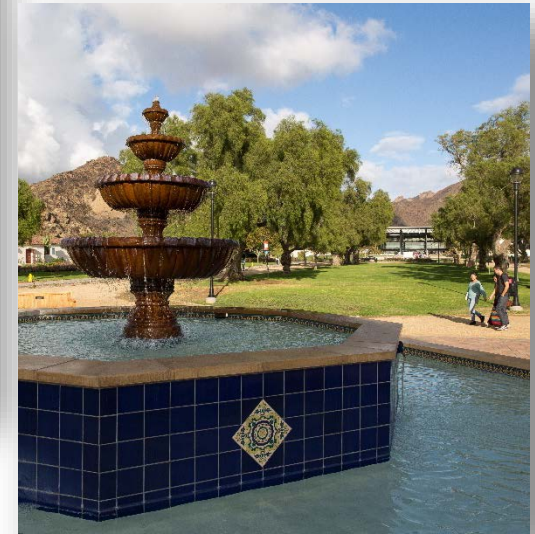
