
CSU The California State University

RCU CARNEGIE DESIGNATION

The University's dedication to student and faculty research has earned the campus a distinguished "Research Colleges and Universities" or "RCU" designation from the Carnegie Classification of Institutions of Higher Education. The University joins 11 of the 23 campuses in the CSU that received the new Carnegie designation and is one of only 216 RCU universities across the country.

HANDS-ON LEARNING

CHANNEL ISLANDS BOATING CENTER (CIBC):

An off-campus facility located at the Channel Islands Harbor in nearby Oxnard, which provides free educational and recreational opportunities for students. The CIBC's Waterfront Program offers various instructional and safety classes in kayaking, sunset kayaking, sailing and stand-up paddle boarding both for campus students and members of local communities.



SANTA ROSA ISLAND RESEARCH STATION (SRIRS):

Provides students, faculty, researchers, and the local community with resources and opportunities to engage in research and other learning experiences via a partnership between the U.S. National Park Service, which governs Santa Rosa Island, and the University that operates the SRIRS within National Park boundaries.
