### What is TPM?



# Time Place Manner Policy

#### When was it revised and implemented?

Effective 11/20/24

• Next Review is: 11/20/25

#### Purpose:

• The purpose of this system wide Policy is to facilitate academic freedom, freedom of expression, and CSU's educational mission while protecting the right to learn and work in a safe environment.

#### What is included:

The policy addresses the mandatory requirements of the "campus climate legislation," including laying out the steps that will be taken to respond to "activities that threaten the safety of students, faculty or staff, and disrupt their ability to access the campus or buildings, the educational process or activities on campus."

# Status of the TPM for Faculty, Staff, and Students



#### Represented Employees

- Still in Meet & Confer process
- Established TPM policies (OP.0 1.0 0 8; 20 18)

#### Non-represented Employees (and non-affiliates)

- Interim policy
- Current addendum

#### Students

- Interim policy
- Current addendum
- Facilitating activity through procedures
- Attending to campus culture and safety considerations



# How to Support Students Navigating TPM



#### Use of Buildings, Facilities, or Grounds

- Understanding of conduct on university property.
- Rules and regulations (public, limited, non-public).

# Public Meetings, Performances, Rallies, Demonstrations, or Similar Events

- Completing forms in advance (e.g., 15 business days in 25Live;
   24hrs for meetings).
- Including required information on host group/organization.

#### **Sound Amplification**

- Thinking through alternatives.
- Maintaining the learning and environments.

# Solicitation (Commercial Solicitation or Non-Commercial Solicitation)

- Review and approval.
- Lim it ed tim e.



#### Handbills/Circulars

Distribution by hand; union activities permitted

#### Display or Distribution of Published Materials

Temporary

#### **Postings**

- Advanced approval.
- Mindful of language used (e.g., not promoting/inciting eminent violence or harm).

#### \*Prohibited activities (legal requirements; safety considerations)

• Encampments/camping; unauthorized structures/barriers; restricting free movement; masking to conceal identity w/intent to violate laws/policies; occupation of buildings/facilities; vandalism/other damage
