Accept Admission

To reserve your space at CSU Channel Islands, you must complete a 3-step intent to enroll process by the deadline specified in our letter offering you provisional admission. The first step is to Accept or Decline our offer of provisional admission. Accept means that you are electing to enroll at CSUCI for and are responsible for completing the next 2 steps of the intent to enroll process: Register for Orientation (step 2) and Pay for Orientation (step 3). Scroll down to the bottom of the CI Records page (under Admissions) to Accept or Decline. Our offer of provisional admission will be withdrawn if you fail to complete all 3 steps by the deadline. Our offer of provisional admission is only good for the term indicated in our offer letter. You may not defer your admission to a later semester. Please check your To Do list often (located on the right side of your CI Records page) for other enrollment requirements and updates. Students are held responsible for checking their CI email and To Do items and complying with all instructions and deadlines. NOTE: The 3-step intent to enroll process does not apply to those individuals enrolling in (a) programs offered through Extended University, (b) graduate and credential programs offered in the School of Education, and (c) applicants pursuing a second B.A. degree

Final Transcript & AP Test Score Deadline:

July 15, 2021



- Final official transcripts have final grades and high school graduation date posted.
- It's the students' responsibility to contact their high school's Registrar Office to order transcripts and ensure their delivery by **July 15, 2021**.
- If you have taken college coursework, please submit those official transcripts as well to receive college credit.
- Official AP scores must be received from College Board as soon as possible. AP scores on college transcripts **are not accepted**.

Freshman Appeal Process:

- 15-business days to submit an appeal from the date on the denial letter via email
- 4-week processing/review time

IMPORTANT:

- Read instructions carefully
- Faxes are not accepted
- Handwritten statements are not accepted
- **Incomplete packets are not accepted!**

Note: You must submit a completed appeal packet via email to admissions@csuci.edu in order for us to properly review your appeal request.

1. Attach a typed statement that explains your reason for appealing. The personal statement must be completed by the applicant. In order for us to best understand the nature of your appeal, please use proper grammar and punctuation.
2. Include documentation to verify any claims made in your statement regarding hardship, illness, or other extenuating circumstances. A personal statement does not constitute documentation. Letters of recommendation will not be considered. **IMPORTANT: Documentation related to sensitive personal or medical issues should be the minimum necessary to understand your hardship, illness, or other extenuating circumstance. Documentation will NOT be returned, so please do NOT submit original copies.**
3. If your email states that your admission was **DENIED** due to not being CSU eligible, then the following documents must be **ATTACHED along with the completed Appeal form AND emailed to admissions@csuci.edu** within **15-business days** of the date on your Denial Notice:
 - o A copy of your high school transcript with sixth-semester grades posted. If you took college courses, then you will also need to include a copy of your college transcript.
 - o Enrollment verification of courses enrolled for the final semester or course grades (if not listed on your transcript).
 - o A copy of any APIB test scores (if applicable).
4. If your email states that your admission was **rescinded or cancelled** because you failed to meet an admission requirement(s), then the following documents must be received by CSUCI within **15-business days of the date on your Rescind/Cancellation email**:
 - o Official Transcripts not previously submitted **directly** to CSUCI from all high schools and colleges attended.
 - o Test scores that were not previously submitted directly to CSUCI by your school or test provider (APIB test scores, if applicable).
