

## **What Students Need to Apply**


Unofficial transcripts You'll be asked to enter all the courses you've completed on your CSU application; those that are currently in progress; and any you plan to take. Transcripts will be requested by campuses as needed.
<b>Test scores (SAT, ACT, AP or IB)</b> Report test results so far as well as any future test dates. Reporting of your ACT and SAT test scores is not required. If you have taken the ACT or SAT and have already sent your scores to a CSU campus, you can add your information to your Cal State Apply Application. If you have not sent your scores to a CSU campus, you can self-report this information but no further action is needed at this time. If you are accepted, your SAT and ACT results will only be used as one of the measures to place you in the proper mathematics and English courses.



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
