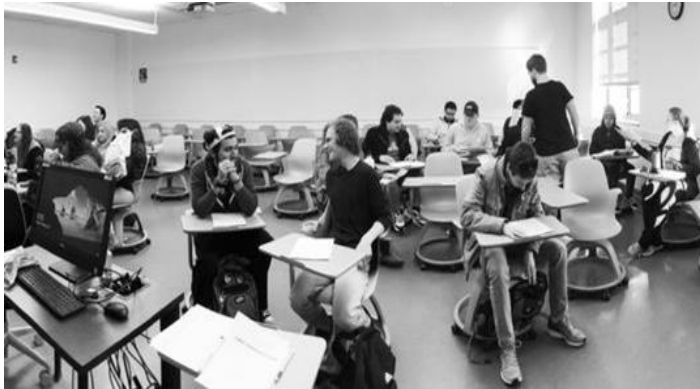
## Tutoring Services and Academic Resources

# LRC Peer Mentor Ambassadors


