






Embedded Peer Educators (EPEs)

LRC Peer Mentor Ambassadors












Visit the LRC to connect with an LRC Peer

Support for Quantitative Reasoning





Chancellor's Office Award to fund Math MINDS

- Co-curricular support program for students enrolled in first credit-bearing math course
- Eligible students receive recruitment invitation at start of semester
- Workshops focused on mindsets and metacognitive strategies for success
- Cohort-based model that connects students with their embedded peer educators for additional skill development
- Community building for peer support
- \$400 scholarship for program participants
