


What is DASS?

DASS assists CSUCI students with disabilities by providing a wide range of support services.






Services DASS Provides


- Student appointments

Students are eligible if...


- they have a documented disability

Majors of DASS Students



CSU Standards

- The CSU has the right to maintain admission, academic, and conduct standards.
- A reasonable accommodation cannot result in a fundamental alteration to an academic program, course or activity.
- The learning outcome of a course cannot be altered.

Do Accommodations Transfer? Sometimes.

Usually Transfer

- Extended time on exams
- Alternative media
- Assistive technology
- Notetaking
- Lecture recording
- ASL interpreter
- Braille documents
- Computer for essay exams

Sometimes Transfer

- Extra absences
- More time on assignments
- Calculator on exams
- Alternative assignment
- Spell check on exams

Do Not Transfer

- Shortened assignments
- Notes on exams
- Alternative grading
- Specialized instruction
