What is EOP?

The Educational Opportunity Program (EOP) is a student centered program that provides college access to students whose economic circumstances have limited their educational opportunities.

EOP aids in the success of students by providing a comprehensive program of active and targeted support aimed at increasing academic accomplishment and individual empowerment.

Who can apply to EOP at CI?

- CA resident or AB540 or DACA student
- First generation college student
- Low income (guidelines given by the Federal Government each year)
- First time freshman (no transfers at this time).
- Historically disadvantaged student that demonstrates academic potential and motivation

Applying to EOP

- The EOP application is embedded within the CSU application located at CalState Apply (https://www2.calstate.edu/apply)
- Letters of recommendation (CSUCI only requires one).
- October 1 to November 30, 2019, priority application period.
- January 15, 2020, deadline to submit EOP applications.
- January 31, 2020, deadline to submit letters of recommendation.
