

CSU Channel Islands University Scholarships

American Association of University Women Camarillo Branch Scholarship

Awarded to a single parent who is an upper division transfer student with a minimum GPA of 3.0.

Airborne Technologies Annual Scholarship

Awarded to students from Ventura County, and preferably from Oxnard, who are studying Business. A 3.0 minimum GPA is required and financial need may be considered.

Art Fund Scholarship

Awarded to Art major students with senior standing. Students must have a minimum GPA of 3.25 and proof of financial need. Applicants will need to provide a portfolio or DVD and an artist statement explaining their work.

Barbara Brooks Scholarship

Awarded to an Art Major Student with Senior Standing in the art department at CI. Must show financial need. Must have a 3.25 GPA. Committee review of: a portfolio for a studio art major, physical portfolio for a painting, drawing, graphic design, ceramics, photography or sculpture student, a reel submitted on DVD for media based students, a major paper on a subject in their field of interest for a history art student. An artist statement explaining their work would also have to be included with the "portfolio."

Bernard and Barbara Bobitch Scholarships in the Health Sciences

Awarded to students in Biology, Chemistry or related fields that enable them to prepare for careers in a health profession. Students must be legal citizens of the U.S. with a minimum GPA of 3.0 from high school or community college.

Business & Technology Partnership Scholarship

Awarded to students with Business, Math, or science career majors. Must be community college transfers or CI juniors or seniors.

California Strawberry Festival Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to students who are Ventura County residents and whose parent(s) have been employed by the local strawberry industry for at least one season. Students must have a 3.0 minimum GPA and demonstrate financial need. The scholarship is renewable for up to four years for freshman and two years for transfer or graduate students.

Carolyn and Harry Lundgren Angel Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to an Undergraduate student. Must be enrolled full-time for the award year. Resident of California with a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Citizens for Youth in Ventura County Endowed Scholarship Fund

Awarded to a Ventura County high school or community college graduate. Voluntary school or community service and financial need will be considered. This scholarship is renewable for up to four years for a freshman or two years for a community college transferee.

City of Camarillo Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to a student from Camarillo. Financial need may be considered.

Delta Kappa Gamma Annual Scholarship

Awarded to a student admitted in the Teaching Credential Program.

Dennis & Joan Gaiser Scholarship

Awarded to an incoming freshman, resident of California with 3.75 G.P.A. and minimum score of 1200 on the SAT-I (combined critical reading and math portions of the exam) or 26 on the ACT tests. This scholarship is renewable.

Dorothy L. Huston Endowed Nursing & Related Scholarship

Awarded to students studying in direct patient care, preferably Nursing. High School or transfer GPA of 3.0 required. Scholarship is renewable for up to four years for freshmen or two years for transfer students.

East Ventura County Employer Advisory Council Scholarship

Awarded to a student working in the Human Resources field. Applicant must be a member, or employee of a member, of the East Ventura County Employer Advisory Council (EVCEAC) to be eligible for this scholarship.

Edward and Eileen Gaiser Scholarship

Awarded to an incoming freshman, resident of California with 3.75 GPA and minimum score of 1200 on the SAT-I (combined critical reading and math portions of the exam) or 26 on the ACT tests. This scholarship is renewable.

Erbie Daw TECA Student Scholarship

Awarded to a student who graduated from Pacifica High School in Oxnard who has completed the TECA program and was accepted to CI with a GPA of 3.0 or higher. Supports students with AB540 status. This scholarship is renewable for up to four years.

Eugene D. and Nancy S. Sweetland Fellowship

Awarded to a student who will be studying abroad. Applicants must indicate where they want to study and why, and they must be willing to share their experience using their own unique style when they return.

Geri and Fred Gretan Nursing Scholarship

Awarded to a student accepted into the Nursing Program.

Gordon Ross Medical Scholarship

Awarded to a qualifying Nursing student.

Hammer Family Trust Scholarship

Awarded to a student with an Engineering, Math or teaching career major.

Jensen-Frazeur Memorial Nursing Scholarship

Awarded to a student accepted into the Nursing Program.

John and Linda Dullam Scholarship

Awarded to an incoming freshman, resident of California with 3.75 GPA and minimum score of 1200 on the SAT-I (combined critical reading and math portions of the exam) or 26 on the ACT tests. This scholarship is renewable.

John L. Notter Scholarship

Awarded to a qualifying student. Must demonstrate financial need. AB540 students are eligible for this scholarship. Priority will be given to Westlake Village Inn employees and /or children of employees.

Judith Frisch Scholarship

Awarded to a student who is the first in their family to attend college.

The Lois & Bill Allmen Memorial Scholarship Established by The Oxnard Gem & Mineral Society

Awarded to an Earth Science career major, but not limited to, Environmental Science and Resource Management.

Margaret E. Garlock Nursing Scholarship

Awarded to students declaring Nursing as an intended major or students accepted into the Nursing Program. Must come from the communities of Oxnard, Camarillo, Port Hueneme, Ventura and the surrounding areas.

Margaret & Lee Wrinkle Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to a qualifying Nursing student.

Mildred Hartung & Beatriz Nunez International Scholarship

Awarded to a student wanting to travel abroad. Must demonstrate financial need.

Nursing Scholarship in Honor of Anna Mae "Tille" Newton

Awarded to a student accepted in the Nursing Program. Must demonstrate financial need.

Oxnard Ambassadors Scholarship

Awarded to a student who has been a resident of Oxnard for at least one year. High school or transfer minimum GPA is 3.0. Student must be a Business major. Student must have financial need as demonstrated on the University's financial aid application. Student demonstration of individual initiative in community service or academic achievement will be taken into account. Scholarship is renewable for up to four years.

The Poe Family Scholarship Fund

Students studying in health related fields (Biology, Chemistry, and related fields). Must be a U.S. Citizen, health science degree preferred, High School or transfer GPA of 3.0 or higher. Students must state why scholarship is needed and why chosen field ZDV VHOHFWHG

Scott Family Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to students who demonstrate individual responsibility and who bring an entrepreneurial spirit to their field of study and future profession. Preference is given to students with demonstrated financial need. High School or Community College GPA 3.0 or higher. Students must complete CI's financial aid application. Students must demonstrate individual initiative in community service or academic achievement will be taken into account. This scholarship is renewable each year, up to four years for freshmen or two years for community college transfer students.

Smalstyte Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a student from/descended from Lithuania. Minimum GPA requirement is 2.5. Financial need must be demonstrated.

The Stephen R. Lefevre Scholarship

Awarded to a student with a Political Science career major. In or entering the junior year at CI. Demonstrated interest in Political Theory, American Institutions, or Public Policy.

Tiplady Burgess Endowed Scholarship for Nursing

Awarded to a student accepted into the Nursing Program. Must demonstrate financial need.

Tiplady Burgess Endowed Scholarship for Educational Opportunity Program Students

Awarded to an EOP student in an appropriate program and demonstrates financial need. Scholarship is renewable for up to four years.
