TYPES OF GRADUATE & PROFESSIONAL DEGREES

- Masters Degree: 2-3 years (depending on program)
- <u>Professional</u> Degree
 Examples: MPH, J.D, MBA...
- <u>Doctorate</u>: 5-7 years to complete (depending on program)
 Highest academic credential





TYPICAL ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- A Baccalaureate degree
- A minimum grade point average (usually a 3.0 or higher).
- An entrance examination (GRE or specified test)
 - Check with school to see if you need to take an exam
 - There may be a GPA required to possibly waive the exam or courses you can use in place of the exam
- Some preparation in the proposed field of study (i.e. internship, research)
- Personal Statement



TYPICAL ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS CONT..

- Resume or CV
- Letters of Recommendation
- Course Prerequisites (as applicable to program)
- Admissions Interview

Admissions requirements vary based on graduate program



FINANCIAL AID

VARIES BY PROGRAM, SCHOOL AND ELIGIBILITY

Financial aid is based on your eligibility and what is available to you at the school. Check with admissions rep. and financial aid dept. at school(s) or your choice to help you understand what could be available to you as a student.

Loans, Scholarships and/or Employer

Merit based funding

Scholarships, fellowships, school or college awards, assistantships


GAPYEAR

The importance of education: 2022 Data


Earnings and unemployment rates by educational attainment, 2022

- Get involved at CSUCI. Look for research, internship and volunteer opportunities




Researching Programs


