"My dad and I have home brewed for years," said Cloud. "He had some previous experience and we took our effort on seriously, using professional-grade ingredients. Our first batch tasted like Sculpin and everyone went crazy over it. We were hooked!"

Cloud says knowing his work impacts others' joy is most fulfilling.

"Somewhere over in Australia, Minnesota, Germany or Hong Kong, someone is waiting to get out of work and crack into one of our tasty IPAs," he said. "It's fulfilling to know what you do makes a huge impact on such a wide array of people."
