### 1) Description of the activity

The ninth annual Noche de Fiesta, presented by El Club de Español, was held on Wednesday, April 16th, 2014, in Malibu Hall 100 from 6:00 to 8:30 pm.

This is a concert and dinner organized every year by El Club de Español and the Spanish Program in which we celebrate the music of the Hispanic cultures. This year our event featured *Invasión Latina*, a popular Los Angeles-based band that has dedicated itself to the performance of bachata music from the Dominican Republic. In addition, a group of bachata dancers performed a few songs in which they demonstrated basic bachata steps to the audience.

417 people attended this event: 348 students and 69 guests/staff/faculty. The music, food and entertainment we had this evening was a huge success.

### 2) Learning objectives of the event

This annual event gives CI students the opportunity to experience traditional cultural expressions that are integral to Hispanic peoples and cultures. All Spanish language courses offered extra credit for attending this event. The students who attended shared their impressions about the music and songs performed by the band in their classes. Spanish 302 students who attended the event wrote a paper about Latin American traditional Caribbean music in which they compared/contrasted the origins and evolution of bachata and salsa rhythms.

### 3) Activity weaknesses

At times during the event, Malibu Hall 100 felt very crowded and there was not much room to dance. Having fewer tables in the future will give us more room to move around.

### 4) Future improvements

Perhaps the brief power point presentation with some facts about the featured country that the audience views before the concert could be extended a little longer and be made more interactive in future events. Students could provide comments or be encouraged to ask questions to the band about their music or country of origin.
