(1) PROVIDE A DESCRIPTION OF THE ACTIVITY;

ESRM hosted two seminars on campus for our interdisciplinary speaker series featuring two speakers from the region who are local experts on coastal lagoons and estuaries and on watershed sediment transport.

We originally intended to invite more guest speakers to our Spring Seminar Series, but as ESRM was involved in a Disciplinary Hire in Spring 2019, each of four candidates presented a seminar and their costs were covered as part of the hiring process.

(2) HOW DID THE ACTIVITY RELATE TO A COURSE(S) AND/OR LEARNING OBJECTIVES?

Our invited speakers addressed current and historical issues in watersheds from headwaters to the coast throughout California. These topics are relevant to many of the environmental concerns addressed by our ESRM courses as well as general program learning outcomes:

- Understanding the resource management issues of the day
- Articulating the interdisciplinary nature of modern environmental challenges
- Proposing novel solutions to existing resource challenges

(3) WHAT DO YOU SEE AS THE STRENGTHS OF THE ACTIVITY?

The speaker series provides students with excellent exposure to local experts in physical and biological aspects of watersheds and helped strengthen partnerships between CSUCI and our community.

Scheduling the activity at a time suitable for most students to attend is somewhat challenging. We addressed this issue by recording the speakers and posting online for later viewing for students unable to attend.
