NOCHE DE FIESTA featuring: IXYA HERRERA AND CONJUNTO HUEYAPAN

The Spanish Program would like to bring Ixya Herrera and Conjunto Hueyapan to perform on campus during our Fifth Annual Noche de Fiesta Celebration. This popular Oxnard-based soloist and group are members of the Herrera Family, a family ensemble that has dedicated itself to the performance of Mexican music. Conjunto Hueyapan was founded in 1973 by Fermín Herrera, a CSUN professor of Chicano Studies who has conducted several important research projects on the preservation and documentation of Son Jarocho, the traditional music of Veracruz, Mexico. Ixya Herrera, who made her stage debut at age 12 at the Tucson International Mariachi Conference singing duos with Linda Ronstadt, has also had a rich and varied musical trajectory. Her rigorous musical training and home experience have prepared her to sing in a variety of styles (classical, blues, rock and Mexican rhythms) with astounding ease and authenticity. Ixya Herrera and Conjunto Hueyapan, who have performed in music venues such as the Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts in New York City, The Kennedy Center in Washington DC, and the Dorothy Chandler Pavilion of the Los Angeles Music Center, have claimed fans both in The United States and Mexico. Please see attachment of biography, reviews and photos. In addition, two photos of our last NOCHE DE FIESTA and poster are attached. We would like to note that CSUCI student attendance to this free event has consistently increased over the past five years, from around 90 students to over 220 students last year.

This function, performed in Spanish with English explanations of songs, will foster students listening skills. Students will be assigned to write their own review of the event in Spanish (which will increase students' writing skills) and demonstrate a reasonable understanding of the ways of thinking, behavioral practices and the cultural products reflected in this kind of music.

This activity directly addresses two of the fundamental pillars of the University mission statement by fostering international and multicultural awareness and understanding as we provide opportunities for CSUCI students to be exposed to other countries' manifestations of popular culture through music.

The Spanish program asserts that this presentation would meet the Spanish program's student learning outcomes, which are:

- Demonstrate a reasonable understanding of the ways of thinking (ideas, beliefs, attitudes, values, philosophies) of the Spanish-speaking world.
- Demonstrate a reasonable understanding of the behavioral practices (patterns of social interactions), and the cultural products (for example, art, history, literature, music) of the Spanish-speaking world.
- To foster students' Spanish language acquisition in all four language skills (speaking, listening, reading, and writing).

Students in the Spanish courses mentioned below will be assigned to write a review of the performance in Spanish. In addition, all other Spanish courses will have the opportunity to earn extra- credit by attending and writing a brief summary of this activity.

2. **Relation to IRA to Course Offerings.** All IRAs must be integrally related to the formal instructional offerings of the University and must be associated with scheduled credit courses. Please list all classes that relate to the program proposed.

Spanish 201 (Intermediate Spanish I, Spanish 202 (Intermediate Spanish II), Spanish 302 (Advanced Spanish, Part II) and Span 311 will integrate this function into its curriculum through the theme of Latin American music to be covered in class. All other Spanish courses will be encouraged to participate.

3. Activity Assessment. Describe the assessment process and measures that the program will use to determine if it has attained its educational goals. Please note a report will be due at the end of the semester.

All students who attend this performance will receive an assessment questionnaire regarding the usefulness of the activity and how they have benefited from it. In addition, students in the Spanish program will write a personal review in which they have to demonstrate an understanding of the cultural topics manifested in the performance. These pieces can be used as assessment instruments to determine the attainment of educational goals.

IXYA HERRERA

Ixya (pronounced ee-shaw) was born in Oxnard, California. Her name is a Mayan word meaning female bird, an auspicious epithet for this young lady who turned out to be a true songbird with amazing vocal purity and power. The youngest of five children, Ixya grew up in a musical family equally conversant with classical, blues, rock, and Mexican music. Her home experience and rigorous voice training from master teachers such as Michael Bondon, Nolan Van Way, Mario Llano Talayera, and Seth Riggs ("Voice Coach to the Stars") have prepared Ixya to sing in a variety of styles with astounding ease and authenticity. Ixya Herrera made her stage debut at age 12 at the Tucson International Mariachi Conference singing duos with her idol Linda Ronstadt. Ixya was later invited by Ms. Ronstadt to do sixteen guest appearances with her in the "Fiesta Mexicana Tour." Other credits include performances at Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts in New York City, the Schwob School of Music River Center for the Performing Arts in Columbus Georgia, the Conservatory of Music at the University of Missouri in Kansas City, Fiddler's Green Amphitheater in Denver, the John Anson Ford Amphitheater in Hollywood, the Teatro de la Ciudad de la Paz in La Paz, Baja California, the Orange County Center for the Performing Arts, Televisa Foro 2 in Mexico City, Convento del Carmen in Mexico City (Recital for Televisa), UCLA's Royce Hall, the San Jose Center for the Performing Arts, the Tucson International Mariachi Conference (alongside the legendary Lola Beltrán), the Las Cruces International Mariachi Conference (also with Lola Beltrán), and the Los Angeles California Plaza. Ixya's first CD recording Primavera (Mexican classics) was released in 1996 to the critical acclaim of publications such as Billboard Magazine (which awarded Ixya a Star for musical excellence), Entertainment Weekly, The L.A. Times, The Tucson Citizen, Farándula Musical, Latin Style Magazine, Frontera Magazine, and others. Ixya's second CD, Cantares Mexicanos, was released in December, 2004. Her third CD will be released in October, 2008.

CONJUNTO HUEYAPAN

Conjunto Hueyapan of Oxnard, California was founded by Professor Fermín Herrera in 1973. The family ensemble has dedicated itself to the performance and research of the *son jarocho*. The group has conducted several important research projects that have resulted in the documentation and preservation of the *son mexicano* in general and of the *son jarocho* in particular. It has performed in colleges, universities, and concert halls throughout the nation, Mexico, and Europe. Group members learned to play *jarocho* music in their native California and perfected their skills under the guidance of master musicians in Mexico City and Veracruz such as Lino Chávez, Mario Barradas, Nicolás Sosa, and others. Conjunto Hueyapan is a family group consisting of four brothers (Fermín, Andrés, and Tomás Herrera), one sister (María Isabel Herrera) and Fermín's two sons (Xocoyotzin and Motecuhzomah).

Performance credits for Conjunto Hueyapan include: Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts in New York City, the Kennedy Center in Washington, DC; the Center for World Music in New York City; the Dorothy Chandler Pavilion of the Los Angeles Music Center; the Filene Center of Wolf Trap Center for the Performing Arts in Vienna, Virginia; President Reagan's 1985 Inaugural Ball; the Hollywood Bowl; the Greek Theatre in Hollywood; Ambassador Auditorium, in Pasadena, California; the Tucson International Mariachi Conference; The Denver Mariachi Festival; UCLA's Royce Hall; the main concert (featured performers of the son jarocho) for the Conferencia Internacional de Arpa in Xalapa, Veracruz; the "Encuentro de Jaraneros" in Tlacotlalpan, Veracruz; the "Encuentro de Huapangueros" in Amatlán, Veracruz; the 1984 Olympic Arts Festival; Festival of American Folklife in Washington, DC; the Performing Arts Center of the University of Texas at Austin; "Siempre en Domingo" Television Program from Mexico City; the Tournament of Roses Parade in Pasadena; The Universal Amphitheater; and numerous other venues and television programs throughout Mexico and the United States. Their CD's, Conjunto Hueyapan de la Familia Herrera, Vols. 1-2 were released in 2003 and 2004. In addition, individual members have been guest performers in concert tours or CD recordings by Linda Ronstadt, Mariachi Los Camperos de Nati Cano, Mariachi Sol de México de José Hernández, Ixya Herrera, Los Lobos, and the rock-en español group, Jaguares.
