Brief Activity Description	To provide students majoring in health communication (Communication Program) or Health Sciences, we propose a guest speaker panel of 3 health communication experts in the field. The focus of the panel will be the importance and relevance of a degree in health communication, the role and contribution of health communication research, and career opportunities in the field. Our goal is to open possibilities for our

	students about the ways their health communication degree can contribute to our understanding of emerging health issues and health administrative needs. All three guest speakers hold health administration jobs with a focus on health communication and have experience applying communication concepts to real-world events. Our expert panel consists of, 1) Lena Dibble, a leading health campaign expert, 2) Kirsten Cady, a previous nurse and now a hospital administrator and 3) Cynthia Wang, director of and International Health Scholar Program. This event, although targeted to health communication and health science majors is open to all majors and will provide a networking opportunity for those students interested in health related career fields.
Learning Outcomes and Relation to IRA to Course Offerings	This event specifically relates to COMM 441: Health Communication (required course for students majoring in Health Communication) but is applicable to students in the health sciences, nursing and any student interested in a health related field. Learning outcomes that this event will specifically address include: Understand the role of communication in relation to emerging health issues.
Description of Assessment Process	Students enrolled in COMM 441 will be asked to write a 2-page assessment linking guest speaking points to concepts and theories discussed in class and course textbooks. This will help us better understand student's ability to contextualize their course lectures. Students attending the event will be asked to fill out an evaluation of the event. This will help us better understand how to structure future events to meet student needs and support curriculum in various disciplines.
