Conditions and Considerations	
Brief Activity Description	The Island Fox Literary Journal provides a medium for students at CSUCI to publish their own creative works. In the fields of Non-Fiction, Fiction, Poetry, and Screenwriting/ Playwriting, students can submit and go through the experience of attempting to have their own work published in a small setting before leaving college as graduates, where the environment is much more arduous for publishing work. It gives students the

	possibility to not only leave CSUCI with a published piece of work, but also the experience, whether rejected or accepted for publication by fellow students, of actually knowing what struggles or obstacles exist in submitting work to a body of people acting as a publishing company. The advertisement of this annual literary journal stimulates interest in the English department as a whole, if not the entire school. It exemplifies the creativity that professors hope to see in their students, and it makes that creativity something physical, something everyone can hold and read, something the school can look back on and glow with pride for.
Learning Outcomes and Relation to IRA to Course Offerings	Students in the ISLAND FOX will master the art of working within a team. They will be able to articulate the basics of publishing a professional journal. They will achieve hands on experience in all aspects of publishing. There are positions available for every member of the class: Managing Directors, Technical Directors, Art Directors, Editorial Directors, Solicitations Director, Publicity Director, Outreach Director, Budgeting Director and Submissions Director. In each position class members will meet deadlines, be responsible for accomplishing whatever the plenary has decided, utilize the strategies the team has decided will be most effective. As a team they will evaluate submitted work, create criteria for acceptance, discuss and vote on each submission, decide on relevant editing, and create an overall framework for presenting the accepted submissions. They will master responsible negotiation with the printing company and with the hired consultants. They will also increase communication and organization skills by creating a handbook outlining how to run the business of THE ISLAND FOX for next year's team.
Description of Assessment Process	THE ISLAND FOX is published on time; it is distributed and shared throughout the school and around the community. The main assessment is in the the journal itself, which has come out on time and to great acclaim at CSUCI every year. THE ISLAND FOX reading is a major event that takes place in the program to showcase the journal. Community members and family members come to hear the participants read from their journal entry. Assessment takes place on a weekly basis as each student involved reports on what they accomplished that week. At the end of the course, students do a peer review to evaluate the success of each member of the class, and of their own accomplishments - according to specific criteria created in conjunction with the professor
