Brief Activity Description	<p>I am requesting funds for book edits. In 2015 myself and CSUCI faculty Sean Anderson sponsored a conference on the ten year anniversary of Hurricane Katrina: "Disaster on the Delta: Hurricane Katrina and the Lessons of Disaster Relief." The conference involved the participation of many CSUCI students who attended or assisted in preparing and conducting the conference, and four students presented papers at the conference. Papers from this conference are now included in a soon-to-be-published book: "Hurricane Katrina and the Lessons of Disaster Relief." Included in the book are two papers by CSUCI faculty and one paper by a CSUCI student, Vanessa van Herden. In addition, two students assisted me in editing the book, Bernice Murias-Aispuro and Mikhail Kadyrov. In short, this book involved the efforts of many people on the CSUCI campus.</p> <p>I would like funds to pay a professional editor in order to deliver a high quality book that would benefit all of the students that participated in the event. In particular the student whose paper will be part of the book and the numerous students that assisted in this project that are named in the introduction. These students could cite this experience in applying for jobs or graduate school.</p>
