In collaboration with the Multicultural Dream Center and Veterans Service, the Serve it UP initiative strives to: 1) contribute to building a Brief Activity Description culture of service at CI though cross-divisional partnerships, 2), create an opportunity between the miniative strives to. I) communicate to uniting a difference in the community 4) create a community amongst CI students, 4), rebrand service as althurstic adventurism. It is our vision that this initiative be student-led with oversight from the CCE, Militaultural Dram Center and Veterant's Services (i.e. the student committee choose the service sites, lead outreach and marketing efforts and implement and oversee the days of service and reflection).
