Brief Activity Description	<p>Communication Asset Mapping is a process where we look to identify places in the built environment on campus that contribute most effectively to the neighborhood communication environment. Such communication assets can be leveraged by practitioners and researchers as places to conduct outreach to gain a better understanding of why these spaces are important communication resources.</p> <p>The process starts by holding participatory communication asset mapping workshops where subject matter specialists present ideas on key environmental communication variables and a cross section of campus community stakeholders have a chance to contribute their perceptions of neighborhood communication assets. This enables student researchers to get a layered understanding of how the campus and its communication assets can be viewed from multiple vantage points.</p> <p>Next, in order to get specific place-specific feedback of the actual communication assets that exist on campus, student participant researchers will conduct communication asset mapping fieldwork on campus to take account of specific types of communication assets mentioned by residents in surveys and focus groups, and note any additional spaces that they determine might have the potential to be developed or enhanced as communication assets.</p> <p>From the data collected, student research team members will create a database of communication assets, map them out visually in an overview map and by sub-area, and create a visual picture gallery of all the communication assets identified. All of this data can then be posted on various pages of the campus website for more general access.</p>
Learning Outcomes and Relation to IRA to Course Offerings	<p>The development of strong campus community relies on open access to opportunities to engage in meaningful face-to-face dialogues in the built environment. Since the built environment can either discourage or encourage said communication, focus on increased understanding, development and maintenance of communication assets is an attempt to move away from a deficit model of understanding community development (i.e., studies that look only at community problems) to a model of understanding focused on recognizing the assets that exist in a community as a way to improve neighborhood vitality.</p> <p>By identifying what are recognized as 'communication hotspots' – where residents gather to talk – and 'communication comfort zones' – communication assets can be used as 'capacity-building blocks' by campus organizations, outside entities, researchers and community members themselves in efforts to build stronger campus communities and strengthen communication networks.</p>
Description of Assessment Process	In addition to surveys and interviews, participatory communication asset mapping workshops will be held to assist researchers and the community in the development of a layered understanding of how a neighborhood and its communication assets can be viewed from multiple vantage points. Summaries of the data collected and communication assets maps created will be made available to the campus community.
