EQUIPMENT: Per the attached proposal, minimum rental period is one day. All rates are daily unless specified otherwise.

LABOR POLICY: Labor costs are not subject to change unless hours are added to event or below policies affected:

-Crew rates are based upon 8 hour days unless specified other. -Hours worked in excess of 8 consecutive hours (overtime) will be billed at time and one-half (x1.5).

EOUIPMENT TRANSPORTATION: Based upon the equipment requirements within this proposal, any freight charges incurred will be charged to the client and are listed in the summary of charges.
