Brief Activity Description

SPED 587 Credentials Seminar: Students attend seminar who are enrolled in credential coursework. In order to address specific student learning outcomes related to disability, collaboration with families, and community resources available to support students with diverse needs, speakers attend seminar to provide workshops and give talks with question and answer sessions to enhance student knowledge on the given topic.

EDSS/SPED560: Access to Learning is a course cross registered between the special education and single subject credentialing programs. This is a large lecture course (last year's enrollment was nearly 70) of all future special education and middle/high school teachers. We invite two to three guest speakers to discuss the following topics which are invaluable to our credential candidates as well as their future students. Topics include: suicide prevention and reporting procedures for K-12 teachers, accessing technology to support students in K-12 assessment practices in California and, if time permits, working with special populations in Ventura County (e.g. children of migrant farm workers, foster youth, incarcerated youth).

SPED/PSYCH 345: Individuals with Disabilities in Society is a required course for students who intend to apply for any of the three credentials offered at CSUCI. Additionally, this course satisfies the general education upper division elective requirement as well as the writing requirement. As a result, multiple sections of this class are typically offered. The scope of the class is to introduce students to the various disabilities which qualify a student for special education services per the law and discuss social and academic implications of disability. Each week a topic related to disability is presented, discussed and analyzed. Instructors often bring in guest speakers to talk about their experiences as a person with a disability, someone who works with or advocates on behalf of those with disabilities or someone who works in a related field. These speakers bring the content to life for students and often are the impetus for students applying to the credential program or applying for work in a related field. Discussion topics are directly tied to course content and curricular outcomes.

5 Speakers in Special Education Seminar (\$200 per speaker- 1-1.5 hours each)

Learning Outcomes & Relation to Course Offering

SPED 587/Special Education Seminar is a course required of all student teachers enrolled in the education specialist credential program. Example of speakers include parents of children with multiple disabilities who share their experiences navigating the school system and community resource providers in an effort to provide perspective for our new teachers.

EDSS/SPED 560 Access to Learning speakers are invited to address student learning outcomes related to working with diverse populations as teachers as well as improve knowledge about the educational system and resources available to support future students in K-12 classrooms. Topics include: suicide prevention and reporting procedures for K-12 teachers, accessing technology to support students in K-12 assessment practices in California and, if time permits, working with special populations in Ventura County (e.g. children of migrant farm workers, foster youth, incarcerated youth).

SPED 345 is a semester long course which meets for three hours per week. Each week a different disability or disability related topic is addressed via readings, lecture and instructor facilitated activities. For years, speakers have enriched the content by providing their expertise and experiences for students on various topics directly related to course content oftentimes. Four examples of speakers by topic are addressed below: Blind/Low Vision: Speaker is blind himself and works with organizations who train and place service animals (seeing eye dogs) with clients in need of assistance. Autism: Speaker is a former student with Autism Spectrum Disorder who talks about her experiences as a student at CSUCI with ASD, how it affected her experience socially and academically. Traumatic Brain Injury: Speaker is a brain injury specialist who works with clients in a rehabilitation facility. Special Olympics: Ventura County: Speaker is an administrator for the local Special Olympics chapter and discusses the mission and charge of Special Olympics. He discusses his own experiences, education needed to work for the organization as well as opportunities for current students (employment and volunteer).

Dates for speakers have not been determined at this time but all will occur during Fall, 2021.
