By providing students an opportunity to see that books are not dead artifacts but vibrant entities with which they can interact through reading, thinking, discussing with peers, professors, and their families and friends (all of whom are invited),we seek to empower them to become engaged readers who incorporate books into their critical thinking. Encountering the author of a book they have read, particularly a famous and/or prestigious author such as several we have had --Jered Diamond, Pulitzer Prize winner Junot Diaz, Muhamad Yunnis, Terry Tempest Williams, Roxane Gay, and Tommy Orange for example - is the culmination of that experience.
