Brief Project Description

Arts and Sciences seeks funding for acoustical panels to be hung in the hallways on the first and second floors of Aliso Hall. Currently, science student research posters are hung on the walls with tape. Unfortunately, after we take down the posters to replace them with new ones the tape is pulling the paint off the wall. We have tried using putty to hang the posters, but it's not strong enough to keep the posters on the wall, as the posters are on display year-round. After consultation with Facilities they recommended purchasing the acoustical panels and having them as a permanent fixture on the walls. The panels are already being used in other buildings on campus and therefore keeps in line with the campus standards. Please see attached photo. That way we will be able to hang the posters with thumbtacks. The panels will also keep us from damaging the walls and will allow us to change out the science student posters easily. Also, as the Biology and Chemistry Programs grow so will the number of students performing research, and by having acoustical panels on the first and second floors this will allow us to be able to hang and display more posters than we currently do. We are looking to implement this project in Spring 2018. This will give Facilities time to
