Belltower Art Classroom Furniture Refresh

Brief Project Description

The Art Program is seeking MSFT funds to purchase new furniture in order to provide an improved classroom experience in our entry-level courses.

Since the earliest days of CSUCI, the Art Program has been fortunate to have a small “foundations” classroom situated at the east end of the Belltower in 1728. It’s in this space that many freshmen take their first Art course – our foundation courses cover the fundamentals of drawing, painting, sculpture, and a host of other practices. BEL 1728 serves a significant number of students—typically 10 sections of Art 100 and Art 102, with each section enrolling 24 students.

As it now stands, this classroom space has not been updated, improved, or refurbished in the 16 years since this university opened. While many new facilities have been built around campus, and many new classroom spaces have received significant attention, BEL 1728 still resembles CSUCI’s earliest days. In truth, it’s a fairly sad scene. The tables installed in the space were makeshift placeholders – they are too small to spread out and work collaboratively. The storage at the back of the room is the original cabinetry from the hospital era, and is not set up for proper storage of the array of supplies needed in these classes. There is computer set up on a rickety cart, and its shoehorned into the front of the classroom so that an instructor can give lectures.

Considering the number of students that use this space (240 per semester), and the fact that this space has not received any attention since the university’s initial opening, we are seeking funds to assist in replacing the furniture and upgrading the overall quality of the classroom. We seek to create an engaging space that will allow greater creativity, dialogue, and an improved boost in student morale. MSFT funds have helped us to do this with other classrooms in the past, and it has been successful. By adding larger moveable studio tables, students can work together, they can work larger, and can engage in more communal projects. The height of these tables is adjustable, making the workspace more accessible, allowing students to stand or sit while they work. In addition to tables, we are requesting the same moveable chairs that are found throughout the Belltower classrooms—the rolling chairs which allow students to move throughout the space, gather in groups, and find a comfortable place to work. The MSFT funds would also go towards a wall-mounted computer so that faculty can give proper lectures, and a large 70” screen which will be more easily viewed by students sitting further in the back of the class. Finally, this project includes a budget for improved storage at the back of the classroom. Considering the program spends a significant amount of student lab fees

on supplies, it seems appropriate to have them situated in a way that is organized and accessible.

Project Assessment:

The goal of this project is to help provide a professional, creative experience for students enrolled in Art foundation classes. We foresee that upgrading this classroom will translate to a more positive environment, creating a space where students can collaborate and move about freely. Many of the students who enroll in these courses are freshmen, and for many of them, it will be their only Art class they ever take at the college level. The effectiveness of the upgraded space will be evident in the high quality work that is produced and more robust engagement with the materials and concepts that are presented. As we have done previously, we will readily acknowledge the support of MSFT funding by providing signage and any other appropriate information in the space.
