Dear Colleagues;

The information to follow describes the areas identified to be included in the interior refresh program for the Bell Tower Core and Aliso Hall autoclave steam generator replacement.

The scope of work for the Bell Tower Core consists of removing and replacing carpet, vinyl baseboard replacement, patching and painting the walls (to the new standard color "Cottage White"), replacing damaged window screens, replacing damaged mini blinds with new roller shades, installation of chair rails to prevent future wall damage and refinishing classroom doors. These finishes are over 14 years old and are at the end of their useful life cycle. We started refreshing classrooms on the second floor of the Bell Tower Core and are requesting funding to continue on with this effort by refreshing rooms 2515 through 2688. These improvements will dramatically improve the learning environment for our students by providing a more comfortable atmosphere while eliminating the deterioration to our interior finishes, which ultimately protect the structure of the buildings.


The campus is moving away from supplying steam to buildings on campus. Therefore, the installation of a small steam generator will produce enough steam to run the two autoclave machines used in the sterilization process for the science labs in Aliso Hall. It would be necessary to remove the old out dated steam return lines. Install new electrical circuit and disconnect for this equipment.

Here is an example of a typical before and after classroom refresh:





The below examples show the current state of classroom finishes – entrance doors are in need of refinishing, there is stained and worn carpet throughout; walls finishes are failing, damages have occurred due to the need of chair rail and window screen material has pulled away from the majority of the frames allowing insects to enter the spaces.





The needs for each room are listed below along with an estimate for the repair; please see the attached estimate sheet for a break down of all unit costs.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: SELLER'S TOTAL AGGREGATE LIABILITY (ARISING OUT OF OR IN CONNECTION WITH BUT NOT LIMITED TO ANY BREACH OF CONTRACT, NEGLIGENCE, TORT, LIQUIDATED DAMAGES, SPECIFIC PERFORMANCE, TERMINATION, CANCELLATION INCLUDING THE REPAYING OF THE CONTRACT PRICE OR PARTS THEREOF, FUNDAMENTAL BREACH, BREACH OF WARRANTIES, MISREPRESENTATION, NONPERFORMANCE, NONPAYMENT, OR ANY OTHER) WHETHER BASED IN CONTRACT, IN TORT, IN EQUITY, ON STATUE, AT LAW OR ON ANY OTHER THEORY OF LAW, SHALL NOT EXCEED THE PAID CONTRACT PRICE. THE BUYERACKNOWLEDGES THAT THE REMEDIES PROVIDED IN THIS CONTRACT ARE EXCLUSIVE AND IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER REMEDIES AVAILABLE TO THE BUYERAT LAW, IN CONTRACT, IN TORT, IN STATUTE OR IN EQUITY OR IN ANY OTHER THEORY OF LAWS.

INSURANCE: Buyer represents that they have a program of Insurance which adequately protects their interest, and that of their employees and agents, including damage to plant, property and equipment, personal injury of any kind, directly or indirectly related in any way to the equipment, service, repair or parts supplied by Seller. Accordingly, Buyer waives any claim against Seller for the foregoing, and on behalf of its Insurance Company, any right of subrogation in connection therewith.






