



## **DIRECTIONS**

With the coronavirus pandemic, families are spending much more time together, and we want to make sure this time is as "healthful" and helpful as possible. The *Family Dinner Card Game* is designed as a simple way for families to communicate their feelings, enjoy their memories, and have some laughs!

Dinner is a great time to play this card game. We have known for many years that when families eat dinner together, there are significant psychological benefits to children and adults. These benefits include:

- Better academic performance
- Higher self-esteem
- Greater resilience
- Lower risk of substance abuse
- Lower risk of teen pregnancy
- Lower risk of depression
- Lower likelihood of developing eating disorders
- Lower rates of obesity

Playing this card game at dinnertime can only add to these benefits, fostering a sense of belonging and mutual support.

The Family Dinner Card Game is easy to play. Family members take turns picking a card and answering the questions. These cards are designed to be "conversation starters" so other family members can add comments or ask additional questions. Of course, you don't have to just play the game at dinnertime. Play anytime your family is together – the more family members, the better!

Above all, have fun.

Print out the cards and cut and fold them as indicated. Put a piece of tape at the bottom of each card to hold it together. There are 8 blank cards for you to write your own questions.

Do you think of yourself as a positive or negative person? Explain your answer.

Is there something you did recently you wish you had done differently?

What is the one thing in the world that makes you happiest?

Give another player a compliment.









What is something positive that happened to you today?

Was there anything that worried or upset you today?

What did you learn today from your work or school?

Did anything funny happen today?









Did you do anything particularly kind for someone today? If not, what might you do tomorrow?

What are you grateful for today?

What is something you would like to tell another family member?

If you had three wishes, what would you wish for?









Describe what your family does for fun when it is really hot outside.

What was the strangest Halloween costume you ever wore? Ask each player to answer this question.

Describe your favorite vacation.

Who in your family would make the best contestant in a talent show?

Describe his or her talent.
