



Suggested Graduate School Checklist Timeline

Six months prior to applying:

- o Research areas of interest, institutions and programs
- Register and prepare for appropriate admission tests
- o If appropriate, obtain letters of recommendation
- o Three months prior to applying:
- Take required admissions tests
- Obtain application materials
- Visit institutions of interest, if possible
- Write a draft of your application essay
- o Get feedback from 3 academic professionals regarding your application essay
- o If needed for medical, dental, osteopathy, podiatry, or law school, register for the national application or data assembly service

Fall: I year before starting graduate school:

- Take admission tests
- Send in completed applications
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the CSS Financial Aid PROFILE, if required
- Spring: I semester before starting graduate school:
 - Check with all institutions before the deadline to make sure your file is complete. Send a deposit to your institution of choice
 - Notify other colleges and universities that accepted you of your decision so that they may admit students on their waiting list
 - Send thank you notes to people who wrote your recommendation letters, informing them of your success
