

## First Year:

- Connect with a Career Counselor to learn about our resources and how we can best support you with the career development process-<u>Schedule a ZOOM Appointment</u>
- Create/Update your Resume-Connect with a Career Peer Mentor and use the <u>Resume</u> <u>Handbook</u> and <u>Resume Resources</u>.
- Explore extracurricular opportunities to gain skills and experience. Review <u>Clubs/Orgs Directory</u> and attend the Clubs/Orgs Fair at the beginning of the semester.
- FOCUS2-Online Career Assessments to help identify values, interests, personality and skills (VIPS) and discover which careers/majors align with your strengths and unique talents.
- Review <u>What Can I Do With This Major?</u>
- Self-Reflect: Ask yourself what you like most about your academic courses and which extracurricular activities interest you most. Adopt a design thinking mindset.
- Research positions that align with what you discovered about yourself. Use Dolphin CareerLink to research and search for positions.
- Create your profile on <u>Dolphin Connect</u> and reach out to a potential Mentor to conduct an informational interview. Informational Interviews help you with career exploration to learn about an occupation that might interest you.
