Step 4: Run Querys to determine what students have a remediation status for EPT (run this every time the remediation process is run)

Query (CI_SR_REM_LIST) will be given to advisors and other helping during Freshman orientation so they know what students should enroll in remedial math classes.

Query () will be given to advisors and other helping during Freshman orientation so they know what students need to take the ELM/EPT test.

NOTE: CSUCI is not tracking students on remediation for EPT due to program at the CO office which allows these students to choose if they take a remedial English class.

Step 5: Evaluate remedial students enrolled in non-remedial classes
