University Glen Landscape Maintenance

FS Contractors will begin trimming the trees located throughout the streets of University Glen. The tree trimming project will be conducted periodically over the course of two years, dividing the community into three phases. The FS Contractors are scheduled to conduct Phase IA of the project throughout December 2016. Phase IA consist of trimming the trees located in the Town Center, Anacapa Island to Frenchy's Cove, Landing Cove to Frenchy's Cove, Elephant Seal to Landing Cove, Cathedral cove to Landing Cove, and Channel Islands Drive from Chapel to Frenchy's Cove.



Valve Exercise Maintenance

FS Staff are in the process of exercising the utility valves located throughout University Glen. The utility valves are routinely checked for ease of accessibility and damages. The valves are tested to ensure that they can readily be opened or closed incase of an emergency.



Trip Hazard Repairs

FS Staff continue to repair trip hazards found in the University Glen community. These repairs entail the removal and replacement of uneven concreate slabs. The replaced concrete contains reinforced metal bars within its structure to ensure that the sidewalk remains longer. This project will provide a safer walking environment for the pedestrians at University Glen.
