STEPS TO PREPARE FOR MOVE IN

1. **MOVE IN TIMES** ARE DESIGNATED FROM 9 A.M. TO 12 P.M. WITH ORIENTATION SCHEDULED FROM 1 P.M. TO 3 P.M.
 2. **PAY ALL STUDENT HOUSING FEES AT OC'S BURSAR** BY 5 P.M. ON 8/5/25*
 3. **SUBMIT YOUR EMERGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION** VIA YOUR STUDENT HOUSING LICENSE WITH OC*
 4. **SIGN THE LICENSE AGREEMENT.** ALL LICENSE AGREEMENTS MUST BE SIGNED WITH OC IN ORDER TO CONFIRM YOUR RESIDENCY WITH US*
 5. **BRING A VALID ID!** PLEASE BRING A STATE ISSUED ID OR YOUR OC STUDENT ID FOR IDENTIFICATION PURPOSES AT CHECK-IN. CSUCI STUDENT IDS MUST BE PURCHASED AT OUR STUDENT BUSINESS SERVICES OFFICE DURING BUSINESS HOURS 9 A.M. TO 3 P.M. LOCATED IN MARIN HALL*
 6. **PURCHASE A VALID PARKING PERMIT.** IF YOU PLAN TO BRING A VEHICLE TO CAMPUS FOR THE SEMESTER. PLEASE PLAN TO PURCHASE A CAMPUS PARKING PERMIT VIA YOUR MYCI ACCOUNT OR VISIT PARKING SERVICES AT PLACER HALL. CSUCI DOES NOT HAVE A PERIOD WHERE YOU CAN PARK WITHOUT A PERMIT.*

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

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TRAININGS

REQUIRED trainings for all students residing in student housing will need to occur and be sent to your OC email. These trainings will include an Alcohol Education course, Narcan and Title IX trainings.

FLOOR MEETINGS

All residents are required to attend the first floor meeting on Sunday, August 24 (we will share more details closer to our general CSUCI Move-In Day). During this meeting residents will be welcomed, receive important updates and expectations for living on campus, and meet their RA and fellow residents.

WASTE DISPOSAL

Santa Rosa residents will have a Food Waste disposal bin in their Family Room. These bins can be lined with plastic or paper liners. Please dispose of food only in these designated bins/receptacles. Once the bin is full, please dispose of all food waste into the brown trash bins located in your village dumpster area.

RULES FOR DECORATING

- Use putty instead of Command Strips to avoid damage
- Avoid tacks, nails, stickers, regular tape, or duct tape on the wall or furniture
- Do not remove the blinds
- Avoid over the door organizers or mirrors
- Avoid anything with an open flame

>>> GRADGUARD

>>> MAIL & PACKAGES

Every resident will have a mailbox in or outside their village office. Your mailbox key will be available in your room upon move in. If it is not there, please complete a key request asap at your village office as of 8/20 or the main HRE office located in Santa Cruz Village, E150.

Students living on campus can receive packages through most delivery services. USPS delivered packages are managed through our Campus Mail Service and delivered to our offices daily, **Monday through Friday beginning 8/25. Please do not send packages prior to this start date to avoid delay of delivery by Mail Services.**

All mailed packages are stored in your Village office mail room. Residents will receive a notification to their OC email address if they have a package available for pickup. Due to limited space, we are unable to accept oversized packages. HRE is not be responsible for the delivery of any packages.
