

Locate the Wireless MAC Address for Amazon Dot, Echo, and other Alexa devices using the Alexa app

Step 1: Download the **Alexa** app from the Apple App store or Google Play store. You can search for **Alexa** on either app store or use the QR codes below.



Step 2: Once installed, launch the **Alexa** app.



Step 3: Sign in to your Amazon account.

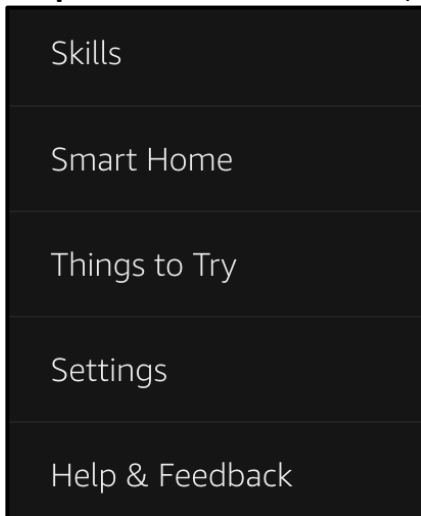

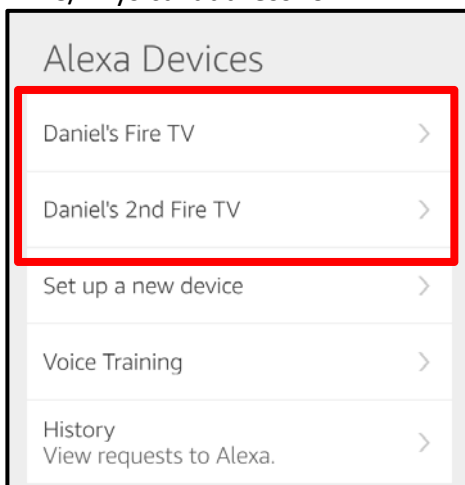
Step 4: Tap the **Hamburger/Menu** icon towards the top left of the screen.
