## **Our New HR System is going Live!**

The Common Human Resources System (CHRS) is a single HR system for all 23 campuses in the California State University system. CHRS is based on PeopleSoft 9.2 with modifications to make it work for CSU campuses. These modifications have been designed by experts from all CSU campuses, and are being built by the Chancellor's Office.

### Go-Live Date: November 13, 2023

- Delivers significant cost and operational efficiencies from having one central system
- Bring new functionality to campuses, especially those with few modifications to current software
- Streamline HR business processes and standardize best practices
- Provide enhanced reporting with standardized data to assist decisionmaking
- Provide an improved user experience in HR applications, including future mobile access to HR services
- Positions the CSU to consider cloud-based technologies
