

# **International Application Checklist for Transfer Students**

Fall Semester Intake (classes begin 3<sup>rd</sup> week of August) Apply October - May Spring Semester Intake (classes begin 3<sup>rd</sup> week of January) Apply August - November

#### CHECKLIST - Documents required for an admission decision:

- CSUCI International Admissions Application <u>www.Calstate.edu/Apply</u>
- \$70 non-refundable application fee can be paid online when submitting the application.

## You can upload the documents below in your Cal State Apply Application or email them.

- Unofficial transcripts for admission purposes only. After admission you will need to send the official transcripts from all colleges or universities attended (official translation required if university does not issue transcript in English).
- **OFFICIAL TOEFL** or **IELTS** (waived if transferring from a college or university in the U.S., Canada, Australia, United Kingdom, South Africa, New Zealand and other countries on a case-by-case basis)
  - TOEFL score of 61 iBT required. Request scores to be sent to code 0236
  - IELTS score of 6.0 required. Email results to <u>international@csuci.edu</u> or mail a copy (score will be verified online with IELTS)
- Grade Point Average (GPA) must be 2.0 or above out of a 4.0 scale. (For transfer students from an institution using a different grading scale we can convert GPA to a 4.0 scale)
- \*Admission requirements may differ depending on your past or current educational background, see table below for admission requirements.

## CHECKLIST – Documents required for I-20 after admission (May be sent before or after admission decision):

- O Copy of biographical page (picture page) of current valid passport
- O Financial Affidavit Form (available on CSUCI International Programs website <u>www.csuci.edu/international/</u>)
- O Proof of financial resources (bank statements, letters of support, etc.)
